line failure between

Conway and Amarillo The failure was weather related.
"Normally in situations of this type, when
our main source of elec
tricity is out, we can switch to an alternate
feed," said local SPS manager Pat Durham.
"However, our alternate feed, Shamrock, had lost its power an hour before
we did, so we had no place to go to get power
The only local damage we
received was a broken pole south of Mclean," she said. "That resulted
in loss of power to six custormers for about 24 hours. We were really lucky that the weather

As in other states. the Texas project addressed the trends and identified critical isues. <br> Among thase issues, the most frequently mentioned tiem by all the state commissions was economic development.
