With the architect and engineer also attending the meeting, a selection was made on the brick, exterior and interior paint and all carpeting for the complex.

Harmon Elliott, chairman of the Muleshoe Housing Authority, said, "Excluding 'down time' due to bad weather, construction of the complex is on schedule. At this point, it is probable the complex will be completed in mid July, 1981."

Elliott also commented that the board was advised that a request for additional funding for more units at the housing complex had been accepted, and earmarked when funds became available next year.

The request was for funding for an additional 16 units. However, the additional units will be in

the future, although Muleshoe was placed at the top of the priority list for senior citizen funds for this area, added the chairman.

Henderson Studies For Sheriffs' Office

Incoming Bailey County Sheriff Bob Henderson attended a 39 hour school in Austin last week for incoming county sheriffs, and according to the officer "It was a most effective school, and I really learned a lot."

He joined around 70 other incoming sheriffs from across the state for the indoctrination school.

He said he is attempting to acquire two schools to be held in Muleshoe shortly after the first of the year, including one for jailers, who must become certified the same as law enforcement officers, and the other for serving civil

papers. Some of the areas covered during the intensive one week training included budgeting; civil process; crime analysis, TLETS operation; jail administration; crime prevention; the Texas Department of Corrections; relationships with the county commissioners court and other elected officers; resources of the Attorney General's office; lab services and evidence; duties and responsibilities of a sheriff; Uniform Crime Reporting; the Texas Commission on Jail Standards and extradition process.

Other pertinent areas were also covered during the school. As the average law officer experience for incoming sheriffs was around seven and a half years, Henderson said the school was conducted on an intermediate, a opposed to a basic level.

Edd Edmiston, recently hired as a jailer at the Bailey County jail, completed training to become a certified jailer on Friday, according to the new sheriff.

Henderson said he is also seeking one jailer, and is currently taking applications for a jailer. Requirements include being a high school graduate, or possessing a GED certificate; able to pass a physical and mental test; be 18 years of age or older; no felony convictions; and be able to attend school to become certified.

Henderson will be sworn in as sheriff on January 1.

Family Displacement Deters Local Standing

Air Force officials conducted a hearing in several locations Thursday to release studies conducted on a possible location, or locations for the proposed MX missile system.

Officials released the information at Kirtland AFB near Albuquerque; Bergstrom AFB at Austin; and bases in Nevada and Utah and briefed various news media representatives on the deployment area selection and land withdrawal statements, as they were released almost six months behind schedule.

AF representatives continued to advocate their preference for the locations in Utah-Nevada, citing that as an alternative, the deployment of the missiles in Texas-New Mexico remains a "viable alternative."

A representative of HDR Sciences of Santa Barbara, Calif., the firm doing the DEIS, said, "It's certainly true that the problem of boom-bust economics will occur." But he added that means to alleviate those problems should be carried out through city planning.

"We'll provide the incentives for construction workers to live in the metropolitan areas," said Frank Fox. "Or, we'll ask that they leave their families at home or have them

live in metropolis areas." Being considered, Fox added, will be life support camps, which will be temporary living quarters.

The large influx of residents, which would also affect Muleshoe and Bailey County, would require up to 23,000 new housing units in the area, with slightly more than 3,000 needed

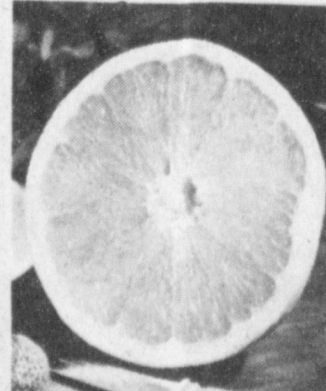

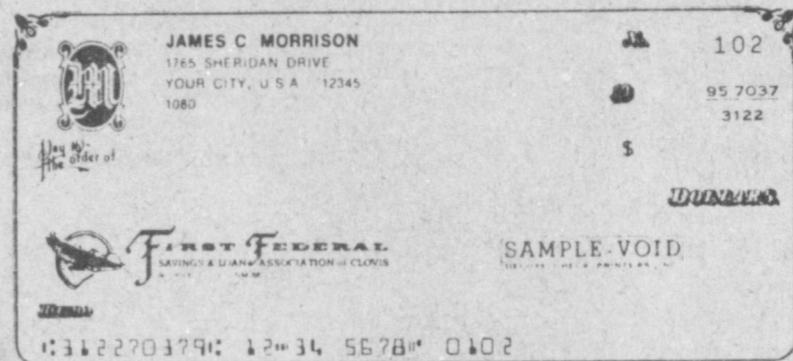

Double Ring Ceremony Unites Miss Wilcox, Bales

A snowy winter wedding took place on November 15 at 7:30 p.m. in the Muleshoe Church of Christ. Ginger Kathleen Wilcox became the bride of Kem Eric Bales. The Rev. David Cox officiated at the double ring ceremony.

Miss Wilcox is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. I.N. (Ike) Wilcox. The groom is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Doug Bales, all of Muleshoe.

The couple stood before an alter decorated with a brass archway entwined with silk white magnolia, silk bell's of Ireland, silk stephanotas and green silk garland. Accenting the top of the archway was white wedding bells and burgandy and white lace bows.

Behind the archway stood a fresh live large schefflera plant. A brass kneeling bench with white velvet cushions centered the archway. Flanking them were two heart-shaped candlebras featuring 48 white tapers and entwined with green silk garland, bell's of Ireland and burgandy and white lace bows. To the far sides of the alter was burgandy and white lacy bows.

The center aisle of the church was laid with a white satin aisle cloth to form the bridal path. Burgandy and white lace bows marked the pews.

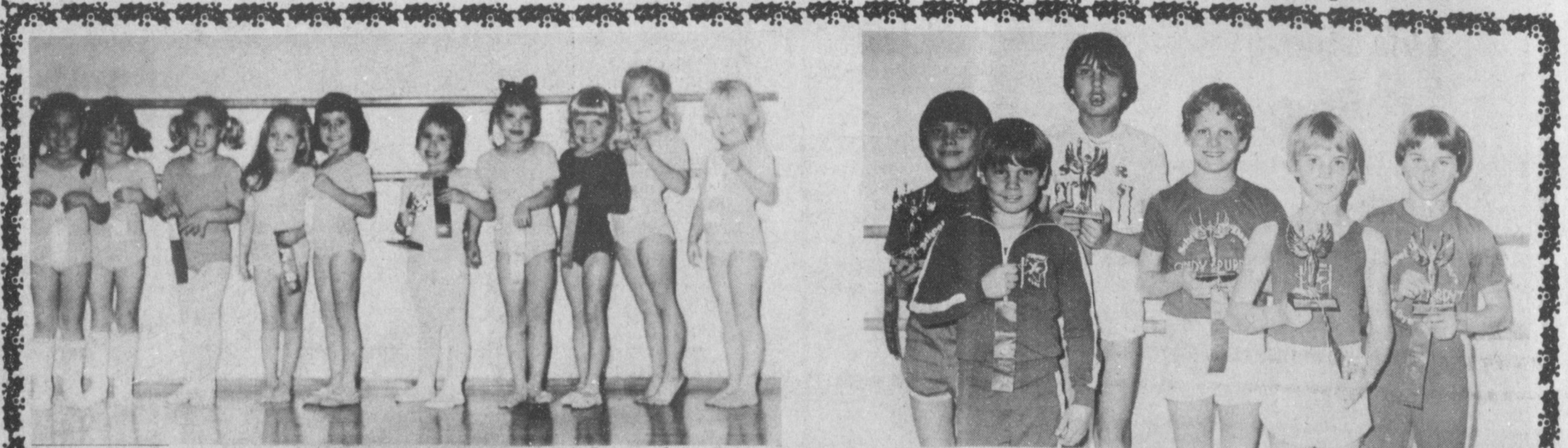

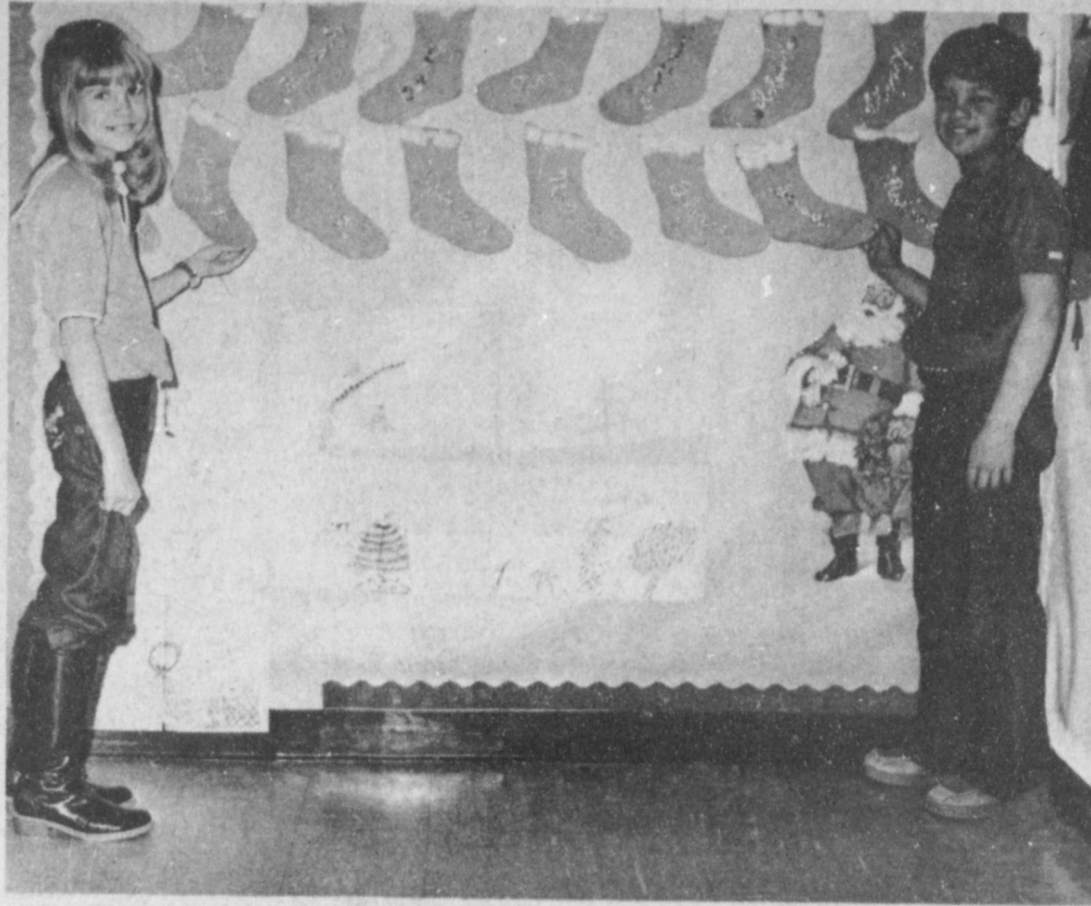

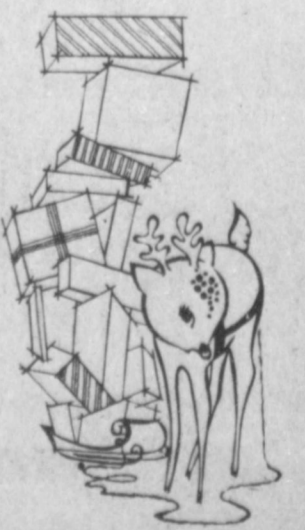

after the project is completed.

In addition, large numbers of health care, education and public safety personnel will be needed at the project's peak. Most of these, however, will no longer be needed at its completion.

With part of the proposed location in Bailey County and the surrounding area, it is expected that a major part of the construction workers and additional required services will go to areas around Clovis, Portales, Hereford and Dalhart.

If the system is located in Texas and New Mexico, up to 1,400 families will have to be displaced and moved. It is considered by many to be unfeasible, as the Utah-Nevada location will require no displacement of families.

Cost estimates for the project range from \$33.8 billion by the Air Force to \$66 billion by the General Accounting Office to \$100 billion by other groups studying the system.

depletion, a particular concern to farmers in the four states, would not be substantially changed by the MX system. The system would use 30,000 acre feet at peak year 1987 and 13,000 acre feet yearly in the system operations.

According to figures by the officials, short term withdrawals from groundwater aquifers will increase depletion rates by up to five percent. "The MX will use only about seven percent of the water," said the official. "we're talking about a very small amount of water."

Liquid fuel is also expected to create little to no problem, as the system contains only solid fuel, with a "very small amount of liquid fuel for one stage of the system."

If the system is located in this area, 146,700 acres of private land in 21 counties, including this county will be needed during construction, with 9,500 acres permanently required. Additionally, it was said the private land consideration would increase the cost of the system.

Concerned officials are still looking at the 'Boom-Bust' aspect of the system, and the fact that in the event more services will be required during the construction years, such extra services would not be necessary, and would serve no purpose once the system is completed, and construction personnel move out of the area.

Split-basing still remains a possibility, and in that event, Bailey County would still have a portion of the system located here, especially in the southwestern part of the county.

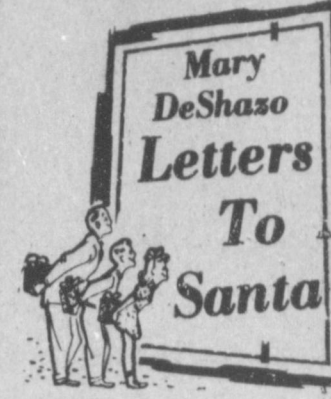
Much opposition is evident here, especially because of the potential water shortage, and the displacement of many of the farmers of the area.

The 90-day comment period for the 1,900-page document will begin

January 2 and end April 1.

A final decision on deployment will be made 30 days following publication of the environmental impact study.

Public hearings will be held by the Air Force toward the end of the comment period, but written comments can be mailed to AFRCE-X/DE, Norton Air Force Base, Calif. 92409.

Laser leveling, which has proven far superior to the old method of eyeballing the mark on a grade stake every hundred yards, has shown some unsuspected advantages like 15 to 20 percent yield increases in some California fields because there are no low spots which are too wet, or high spots which dry out. Because excess water is not necessary to water high spots, water can be applied uniformly. And, laser leveling has proven beneficial in preparing an ideal seedbed, with greater precision in the planting of seeds and the placement of fertilizer. First used in the 1976-77 California drought, laser leveling uses a continuously rotating beacon which sends out a 360-degree plane of laser light, providing a continuous fixed elevation.

Joseph and Mary: A Story of Devotion

With all the wonder of Christmas, one of history's most beautiful love stories is often overlooked: the devotion shown by Joseph toward Mary, the mother of Jesus.

The Gospel accounts don't tell us very much about Joseph, other than that he was a "just man," who did not wish to expose Mary to reproach when she was found to be with child. In keeping with Jewish tradition of the time, he planned to divorce her quietly, before the required two witnesses, and avoid a public scandal.

But, before he had time to act, his bitter disappointment with Mary was turned to joy. An angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, Matthew tells us, and said to the troubled man, "Do not be afraid, Joseph, Son of David, to take to thee Mary thy wife, for that which is begotten in her is of the Holy Spirit. And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name Jesus; for he shall save his people from their sins."

Now, a messenger from God was telling him that Mary, his betrothed, was to be the mother of the Messiah! And, Joseph was to be her husband!

Joseph instantly set aside any past doubts and misgivings, the Gospel tells us, and "did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him." From that moment, the portrait of Joseph in scripture is that of a faithful companion to Mary.

It is Joseph who searches for lodgings in Bethlehem when it becomes apparent that Mary's time has come. It is Joseph who is at her side when she brings forth the infant Jesus, under the gaze of the creatures of the stable.

And, it is Joseph who names the infant Jesus, as he had been commanded.

And, when the scheming Herod threatens the infant's life, Joseph is the one who is warned to take the mother and child into Egypt. Matthew tells us that "He arose, and took the child and his mother, and fled into Egypt."

angel again appeared to Joseph. Again, he obeyed without question and took his wife and the child Jesus back to Israel, to resume the life that had been interrupted.

In Nazareth, where Mary and Joseph settled down with the young Jesus, the carpenter continued in his devotion to his family. When Jesus was twelve and became separated from them while on a visit to Jerusalem, Joseph and Mary searched for Him for three days. How their hearts must have ached as they combed the city. Mary even remonstrated with the young Jesus: "Behold, in sorrow thy father and I have been seeking thee."

St. Luke tells us that the boy Jesus returned to Nazareth with Mary and Joseph and was subject to them. He even followed Joseph's trade as a carpenter before beginning His ministry.

Tradition has it that Joseph died before that ministry began. But the

Holly is natural rebirth symbol

The bright colors of holly, with its glossy green leaves and vivid red berries, make it a natural symbol of rebirth and life in the winter-white mantle of northern climates.

Holly occupies an important place in the legends and lore of Christmas, as well as being credited with having magical and medicinal powers.

It was believed in England, long ago, that prickly holly with its spiny leaves was "he" holly and that the smooth leaved holly was "she." Whatever type of holly was brought into the house first at Christmas would determine who would head the household—"he" or "she."

Another legend observed that if holly was brought into the house on a fair day, the wife would rule, but if the weather was bad, the husband would be the master.

And curiously, holly was believed to cure toothaches, banish rickets and possibly foretell the name of a future husband to a questioning young woman.

Teutonic people, in late December, traditionally placed holly and other evergreens around the inside of their homes, hoping to ward off unwanted spirits and bad weather.
