Constitution

#### EDITOR AND MANAGER Senate Joint Resolution No. 7

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Texas by amending Section 33 and Section 40 of Article 16 of the Constitution of Texas so as to permit officers of the National Guard, the National Guard Reserve, and the Officers' Reserve Corps of the United States and enlisted men of the National Guard, the National Guard Re-serve, and the Organized Reserves of the United States to hold public office ih Texas, Be it Resolved by the Legislature

of the State of Texas: SECTION 1. That Section 33 of Article 16 of the Constitution of the State of Texas be amended so as to read as follows:

The accounting officers of this State shall neither draw nor pay a warrant upon the Treasury in favor of any person, for salary or compensation as agent, officer or appointee, who holds at the same time any other office or position of honor, trust or profit under this State or the United States: except as prescribed in this Constitution. Provided, that this restriction as to the drawing and paying of warrants upon the Treasury shall not apply to officers of the National Guard of Texas, the National Guard Reserve, the Officers Reserve him as his own."
