Swept by Fire

Galveston, Sept. 30.-Lashed bs a 30-mile-an-hour northeast wind and rendered difficult to cope with fumes from burning sulphur, the fire which started on the docks today was brought under control after doing damage estimated at between \$1,250,000 and \$1,000,000. The latter mark will be reached, according to underwriters, if the cargo of wheat of the Calian Steamship Company

The fire originated in the plant of the Texas Gulf Sulphur Company at 2 o'clock and spread rapidly until all of pier 35 was ablaze. An explosion of oil drums firemen reached the scene and tne plants of the Cotton Concentration Company, the Anchor Milling Company, and the super-Etna caught fire.
