



Never put sweepings of pen in bag with wool; Never put over 225 to 230 pounds in a bag; Never sack old ewes' wool with your young wool; Never keep your sheep in dusty pens; Never sack black and buck wool with your other wool;

Never shear your sheep on the ground; Never shear your sheep with burrs in the wool: burr them before shearing.

Never sack your twelve months wool loose; tie with paper fleece twine, every fleece to itself, white Never leave the tags in the wool; take them out and

sack separate; Never get the sacks dirty; keep them clean and make every bag look the same;


