



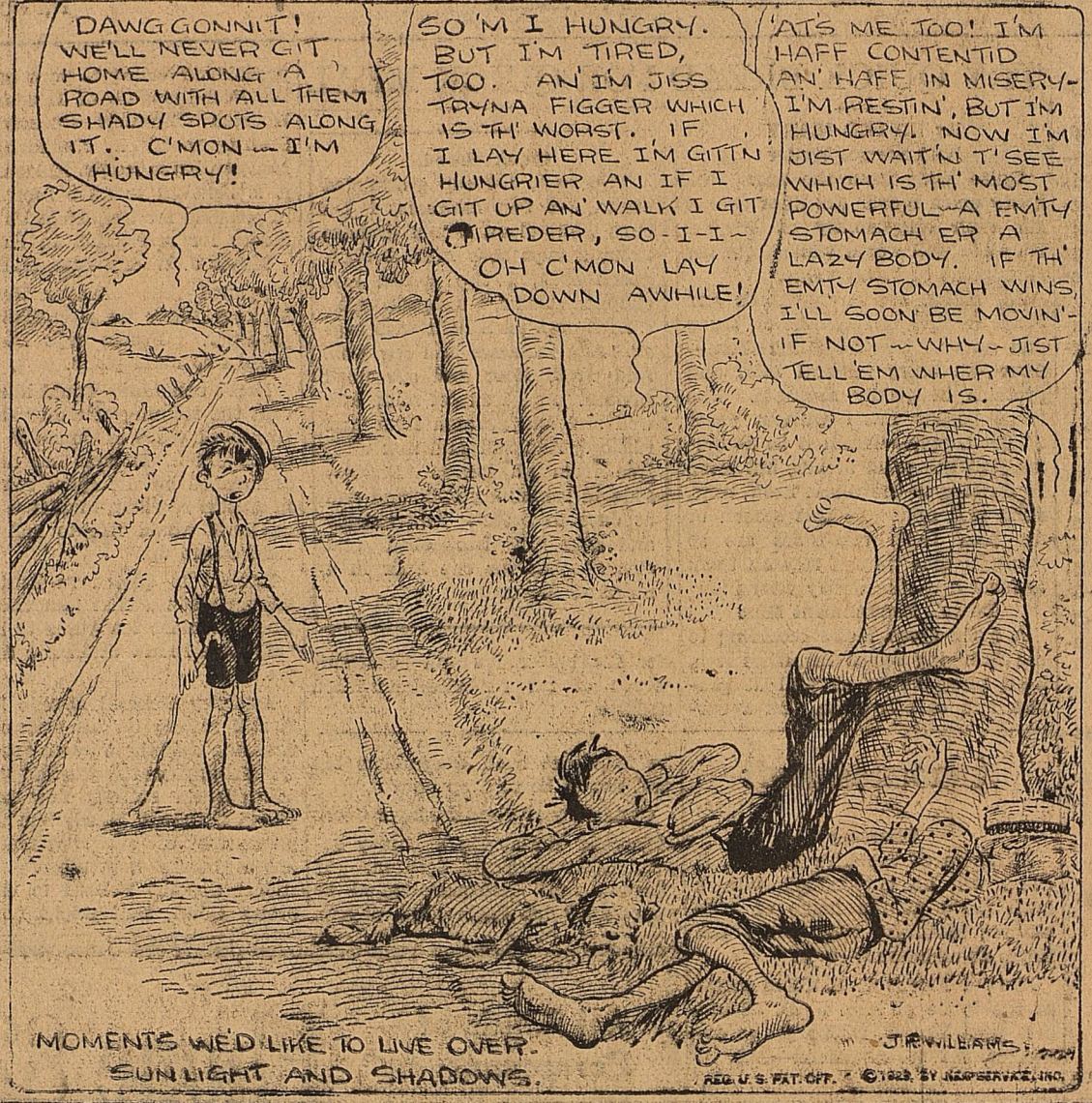




BRITISH AND U.S. CARS COMPETE IN AUSTRALIAN TEST
