Gas Masks Sold in a Paris Store

French Air Fleet Plans Long Flight

PARIS. (UP).—A nervous Parisian, worried over the recent war scare throughout Europe, has discovered that gas masks are for sale in department stores. This is the first known instance since the World War of any civilian seeking to buy a gas mask here, although since the Armistice nervous peasants in frontier towns and villages have been known to spend their savings on protection against gas attacks. The Paris purchaser was an aged woman, who went to one of the large department stores near the Opera and asked a clerk where she could find a gas mask. She was considerably surprised when the clerk directed her immediately to the department existing gas appliances. The model, copied after the military type, cost about \$9. She hurried home, the mask under her arm. Directors of the store revealed that in recent weeks they had received numerous requests for masks. To supply the demand they asked the army gas division to provide them with them, but the request was refused, as the military models are designed solely for army use. PARIS, May 1 (UP).—France will launch a most ambitious air expedition, in point of size, next November, when 10 fighting planes hop off for a flight of more than 4,000 miles. The air fleet probably will take off from Le Bourget and other fields in the Paris vicinity, and fly in formation to Marseilles. The next stage of the flight will be Oryan, and thence by overland stages to Egypt. Air Minister Cot, who is a licensed pilot, probably will accompany the fleet, although command will be vested in an officer of the aerial branch of the army. The French expedition has two objects: to demonstrate the practicability of despatching a large aerial flight on a long expedition, which might be required in time of war; and to demonstrate to the world generally the efficiency of French planes and pilots. In the months between now and the take-off of the fleet, Air Ministry and army officials will collaborate in preparing for the flight. Not only must all the participating planes undergo the most severe tests, but arrangements must be made for enormous supplies of gasoline en route. In addition, landing facilities for 100 planes, must be provided, in itself a considerable problem. There is a greater possibility of life on Venus than on Mars. Tremendous technical resources were employed in producing "King Kong," the feature picture at the Yucca preview Saturday night.

The production shows prehistoric monsters fighting each other and recreates the sounds they must have made while living.
