"In" <br> deatt. Was that he strongly refused to visit a doctor on a regular basis. "The newspapers have reported that Fixx had not been to the doctor in several years. At the $Y$ we encourage people to see their doctor egularly and especially before beginning an exercise <br> In reaction to the concern about participant safety, the $Y$ in <br> Spearman has established a new policy concerning fitness class participation. Starting with this

fact, Jim Fixx's death confirmed the $Y$ 's stand for aerobic exercise." Crenshaw stated. The new law states we will not have social promotions in the future Driver Education state funding has been discontined. Funding for this program must; therefore, be provide by the local district and the students.
The law speaks to these two areas as foliows: quirement for 21.721 . Grade Re credit. (a) A district may not grant social promotions. Students may be promoted only on the basis of academic achievement. (b) A student who has not maintained a grade average for a 70 on a sale of 100 may not be advanced from one grade level to the next.

on a scale of 100 may not be given credit for the course. (d) The State Board of Education shall adoptrules proscribing for students who are consistenly unable to be promoted because of poor academic achievement, and a district may provide for those students in accordance with the board rules, provided tht the parent, guardian, or person having lawful control of the student participates in the deliberations.

The use of a grade of 70 on a scale of 100 for determination of whether students may be advanced from on grade level to the next or receive credit in a course applies to grades 1-12. Districts may convert numerireporting purposes if they derepo

Education to Sub-con Code, is transferred to Sub-chapter D, Chapter 21, and is follows: Sec. 21.102. Driver Education. (a) The Central Education Agency shall develop a program

(b) With the approval of the State Board of Education, the commissioner of education shall establish standards for the certi-
fication of professinal fication of professional and
paraprofessional personnel who paraprofessional personnel who
conduct the programs in the public schools.
State funds to school districts for driver education programs are being discontinued effective the 1984-85 school year. However, school districts may continue to offer programs of organized instruction in driver education and traffic safety for public school students who are
