



Cudd, who sells Deere sleds out of Hansford Implement, figures that in his two-county sales area, there are about 100 sleds.

Where do the people ride? One place is Chama, New Mexico, a six-to-seven hour drive from Spearman. Many of the snowmobilers travel that distance five times a season just to experience what Mike calls '-- the excitement of the mountain wind drifts."

'There's plenty of time for recreation." states Cudd, since Spearman is basically a farming and ranching community and winter is the people's recreation time of year. When there's snow at Spearman, the people snowmobile near home, but when there isn't, they drive long hours to winter snomobile ing fun.
