New Lines in Texas Built During 1906.

Special to the Globe-Democrat.

Austin, Tex., December 25.—R. A. Thompson, engineer of the state railroad commission, has compiled a complete statement of the new miles of railroad constructed in Texas during the year 1906. The number of miles of new road for that period is shown to be 648. It is believed that Texas has led all other states this year in railroad construction. In addition to this completed mileage, there are 1427 miles of additional road surveyed or under contract for construction, and much of it will be completed during the coming year.

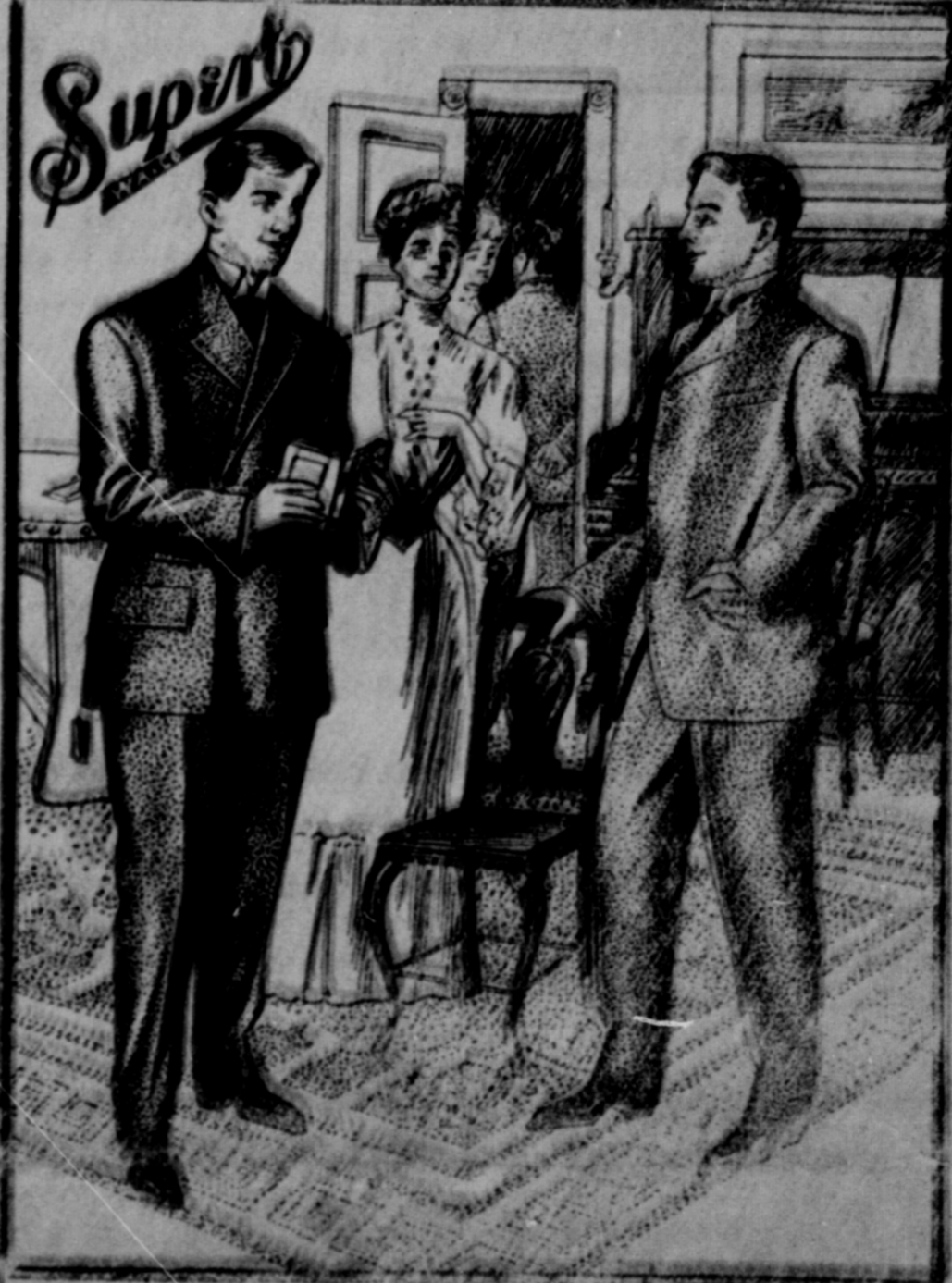
The new mileage constructed during the present year is as follows: Abilene and Northern, from Abilene to Stamford, 40 miles. Beaumont, Sour Lake and Western from Sour Lake to the Trinity river, 25 miles. Beaumont and Great Northern, from Trinity river to Anadaska, 15.7 miles. Galveston, Harrisburg and San Antonio, from Cuero to Stockdale, 47 miles. Houston and Texas Central, from Mexico to Navasota, 94 miles. Houston Belt and Terminal, in city of Houston, 8 miles. Kansas City, Mexico and Orient, Sagerton to Knox City, 21.9 miles. Plainview and Northern Texas, from Canyon to Plainview, 57 miles. St. Louis Brownsville and Mexico, from Alcoa to Brazoria, 26.6 miles. Texas Central, from Stamford to Dowell, 45 miles. Trinity and Brazos Valley, from Mexia to Houston, and from Teague north, 208 miles. Wichita Valley, from Seymore to Stamford, 60 miles.

The lines which are projected and under construction are as follows: Weatherford, Mineral Wells and Northwestern, from Mineral Wells to Texas-New Mexico state line, 275 miles; Kansas City, Mexico and Orient, from Sweetwater to San Angelo; and from San Angelo to Spofford or Del Rio; and from Knox City to the Red River, 150 miles graded, 600 miles; Beaumont, Sour Lake and Western, from Trinity river to Houston, 45 miles; Beaumont and Great Northern,

from Analaska to Livingston, 15 miles; Brownwood and Cisco, from Brownwood to Cisco, 55 miles; Chicago, Rock Island and Gulf Carrollton to Irving, 12 miles; Gulf Colorado and Santa Fe, from Brownwood to Texico, 350 miles; St. Louis, San Francisco and Texas from Brady to San Antonio, 150 miles; Port O'Connor, Rio Grande and Northern, from Port O'Connor to San Antonio, with several branch lines, partly graded, 350 miles; Texas, New Mexico and Pacific, from McKinney to Denton, 30 miles; Trinity Valley Northern, from Dayton to Cleveland, 30 miles; Wichita Fall and Northern, from Wichita Falls to the Red river, 20 miles.

All of these projected roads are tangible propositions and been financed. There are many other proposed roads which are not included in this list of projected lines.


