Hard on Automobilests.

Gov. Campbell this week signed the oill regulating the use of automobiles in the state of Texas. The bill fixes eighteen miles an hour as the maximum rate of speed at which automobiles may be run in the country, and eight miles in town, unless the rate should be made different by municipal ordinance. Every owner of an automobile shall register with the clerk of the county in which he resides. and the automobile must be numbered, the figures to be six inches tail. A registration fee of 50 cents is to be charged. Racing is prohibited on a highway. The bill requires every driver of an automobile to stop when the driver of a horse vehicle signals for him to do so. The penalty for any violation of the law is a fine of from \$5 It becomes effective to \$100 ninety days after the adjournment of the regular session. - Heretord




