when Mississippi Power Company sained control of a co－op＇s boand and changed the bylaws allowing 200 members to cast 12,000 votes． Pence explained that in recent ears，several investor owned utili－－
ies have become＂cash－rich，＂ ies have become＂cash－rich，＂
