




SPEARMAN WAS MADE A FULL-TIME CHARGE by ANNUAL

HISTORY OF THE SPEARMAN METHODIST CHURCH

On February 17, 1901, McKeown preached his first sermon in Hansford County. He preached in the Ace Powers home, north of Old Hansford on Palo Duro Creek. On July 1, 1901, the Hansford Curreh was organized. This meeting was held under a cotton wood tree, east of the Powers home, about 60 or 70 yards from the ranch house. This house is still in use and is now owned by John R. Collard, Sr., Spearman.

The twenty charter members were as follows: Wallace Mc-Kay, Miss Geneive Curtis, Miss Ella Curtis, Zenas Curtis, Mr. Zena Curtis, N. B. Crosby, Mr. S. B. Crosby, Ace E, Powers, Mrs. Ace E. Powers, Charles H. Bellah, Frank T. Wright, Tom Land, Dr. W. H. Langston, B. P. Ward, David J. Wilson, I. P. Mulock, Mrs. I, P. Mulock, and Miss Lizzie Powers.

Of these twenty, so far as can be ascertained, only one is now living—the former Miss Lizzle Powers, now Mrs. E. R. Jarvis, of Perryton.

Being without a bulifding, the members held services in the court house until 1912 when a temporary building was built. Rev. J. B. Osorne, now of Ciscoo, Texas, was paster at the time.

In 1916, the building now in use was built at Hansford. The church was dedicated May 21, 1916. Rev.. S. Walsh Franklin, now of Dewey, Oklahoa, was pastor, The building committee consisted of A. F. Barkley and R. F. Dennis, both now deceased, and R. L. McClellan of Spearmas.

In 1919, when the Santa Fe built a railroad into Hansford county and Spearman was started, Hansford was moved to the new town. The Methodist church moved in 1920.

The old building was used until 1949.

The new church building fund was actually started in 1938 by the Womens Missionary Society, although it was the hope and dream of the members for years preceding to have a larger, better place of worship. Many of the members who were so active in the plans and hopes for the new church did not live to see the fulfillment of their dreams. For these, Memorial services were held in the old building on Sunday, July 10, 1949.

Many of the present membership were present at the dedication of the building in 1916, and worshiped in it with their children until the new building was declicated in 1949, Notable among these is the McClellan family, which is the only family that has had four generations who were members in the church, according to the records.
