All elevators of the north plains area urge yoy to check carefully before you start harvestigg your grain this year.
It is a known fact that many elevatorsm this area sacrificed a large part of their profits last year because they accepted wheay that was green, or wheat that had too much hoisture content. Most elevators try to exterd every favor possible to wheat producers, bt one elevator reported a total loss of $\$ 25,0000$ in Hansiord County because of wheat thy was too green, or which had too much mojure content. The elevators must protect the future. Meaning all the elevators of the non plains area, urge you to wait until your weat is ready for harvesting, or condition it befye you offer it for sale or storage.

In the matter of storage we do not feel alarmed at this time, but we do want wheat producers of this area to realize that if there is a shortage of government approved storage that it will be because the terminal elevators and warehouses are not in a position to accept wheat as we elevators of this area ship the 1949 harvest to the terminal market. As it looks at this time many bushels not formerly stored on farms must be stored on the farm this year, at least as a temporary measure. Your Gruver elevators are making every effort to serve the wheat GROWERS of this area, and you may rest assured that we will take care of all the storage that is physically possible to handle, but we do want wheat in condition for storage before we accept it at the ELEVATORS in the north plains area.
