ductlon and tacrease fabor cost, whille the modern barns increase production and cut labor costs.
It is economy when builatigs to butld
it well. That is espectally true of barns
that are to house live stock and thetr feed. Every farmer who needs a new bulding of this type should bear these
facts to facts to mind.
