## EDITORIAL

 RECOVERY ON THE WAYPresident Roosevelt's first words on landing at Charleston after his long cruise were: "We are on our way back
There is a great deal in the record of business conditions to back up that statement. Compared with the time of his return from Hawaii in 1934, business is certainly better. Carloading, always regarded as an excelent index of business activity, are nearly 25 per cent greater. The stock market average price of the 50 best stocks was $\$ 110$ a share when he landed at Charleston, as against $\$ 79$ a share when he landed from Haw aii. The excellent general business as compared with 79.8 a year ago, is now 88.8 . Industrial employment in business conditions. is better. On the whole, the President's statement that we are on our way back,
seems entirely correct.
Mr. Roosevelt amplified his statement by adding, We are coming back solidly because we planned it that way, and the fact that business is better, is be cause we all worked to that end.
Of course the opposition still says, "That business would be even better If Washington would let it a lone, but Mark Twain said, " Without competition there would be no horse races.

## COMMON SENSE FROM MR. FORD

Whenever Henry Ford can be induced to comment on public affairs, he usually says something that reeks with sound common sense. To an interviewer the oth er day, who had suggested that economic affairs are ut of gear, Mr. Ford replied:
"How long has it been since everything was all right? In what year was everything working perfecty, or pretty nearly so
A great deal of loose thinking and loose talking about the condition of the world and of our own sect ion of it seems to be based upon the false and foolish
notion that it was not so very long ago that everything was perfect. Everybody had a job with good wages, all businesses were prosperous, all banks were sound all brokers were honest, crime was practically unknown and all the farmers were making money and keeping out of debt! Then something, perhaps manipulated from Wall Street, happened, to throw the whole economic system into choas.
That is about the way a great many people look at present conditions. They think they were brought about by some malignant outside force. It does not take a long memory or more than ordinary common sense to realize that that point of view is utterly absurd. As Mr. Ford put it:
"We always imagine ourselves to be the poor innocent victims; we seldom think of ourselves as part of the guilty cause."
