 bring tax reliefIs the land you own beinc used then you may be eligible for tax relief on that property. According to Alioe Peddy, chief appraiser of the Hensford County Appraisal District, landowners can apply for special lower valuation of their land besed on what it will
produce rather then what it produce rather than what it would
sell for in the open market. Landowners should market. May 1 this year for any property to receive agricultural-use valuation, or for open-space lend valuation of any property that did not recoive that type of appraisal in 1984. Applications made after May 1 and until the appraisal records are approved are subject to penalty for
late filing. Mre.
Mrs. Peddy said that the legal
basis for special land appraisal is in the Texas Constitution in Art. 8, Secs. 1-d and 1-d-1. "The two types of lend and valuation are commonly called ag-use or 1-d and open-spece or 1 -d-1," she added. tion and for qualification of both tion and for qualification of both ferent for the two types of apferant for the two types

For 1-d ag-use valuation, the
owner must apply to the chief appraiser each year. The land must be owned by a "natural person," not a corporation, partnership,

clusively to agricultural use for at least three years before the year application is first made; and the agricultural business conducted on the land must be the owner's primary occupation and souroe of income.

ditional tax is created under 1-d ditional tax is created under 1 1-d or by additional tax is created under 1-d valuation either by sale of the land or by a change in use of the land. The rollback extends back to the three tax years prior to the year in which the changes or sale
occurs. occurs.
Under $1-\mathrm{d}-1$, a rollback is trignonagricultural purpose that would not qualify for productivity valuetion. Taxes are recaptured for the five years precoding the year of the change.
The additional tax is measured, Mrs. Peddy said, by the difference
between taxes paid under between taxes paid under pro
ductivity valuation provisions an the taxes that would have been paid if theland had been put on the tax roll at market value.

Mrs. Peddy noted that owners of agriculture lands loceted in more agriculture lands located in mon
than one appraisal district must apply for productivity valuation with each district. Failure to do so could result in one or more taxing units taxing the land on its fu market value

## Property renditions due May 1

Alice Peddy, chief appraiser for Hansford County Appraisal District, reminds district residents that appraisal office before May 1 . A rendition lists taxable property on a special form available at the
appraisal office, and can inctude appraisal office, and can include
the owner's opinion of the property's value. Anyone who on J Jnuary 1 owns or manages tangible per sonal property used to produce income must render that property for taxation. Bxamples of personal property which must be rendered are business inventories, office vechiles.

## vechiles

Property owners must file renditions with the chief appraiser of the county appraisal district in chief appriorty is located. The chief appraiser may also require a property that hany other taxable by delivering written notios of the rendition requirement and an appropriate rendition form.
Although Texas law doesn't re quire the average property owner to render a home or personal property not used to produce income, anyone may voluntarily file a rendition with the appraisal
district. district.
Rendition
Rendition is a means for the
taxpayer to record his opinion of his property's velue. By rendering the property's value. By rendering the advantage of being sure he'll get notice if a higher value is placed on the property by the appraisal office, allowing the owner time to protest the val
