"First, it will allow DWI fines to more accurately reflect the work that goes into the convictions. Citites make the lion's of the initital paperwisk while the counties handle most of the pro. seaution. "Secondly, we think this bill will give city police forces more incenuve to make DWI arrests. The don't have any real incentive righ now, other than their own profesbeneficial for them to make public Intoxication arrests,", he said With Sarpalius at the press conference was Ted Willis, executive director of the Texas Municipal League. Willis said S.B. 628 would give a financial boost to most of the slate 's cties. Marinelle Timmons Drunk Driving (MADD), also Drunk Driving (MADD), als attended the pross conference to express her organization's support for the measure. Sarpalius initially considered splitting DWI fines in 1983 when he passed his landmark bill toughening Texas' DWI laws. '"One look at the DPS' ${ }^{1983}$ statishics and I was convinced that something needed to be done," he said. "Cities weren't getting any money, yet they were doing a

The DPSD statistics, he said, ${ }^{\text {ncticated that Dallas police make }} 103 \mathrm{DWI}$ arrests for every one DWI arrest made by the Dallas County Sheriffs O Office. The ratio is 16 to one in Fort Worth and 10 to one in Houston.
He also said those same statistics indicate that an unusually high arrests are being made by some police depertments.
"We're not saying that some cities are doing anything wrong," Sarpalius said. "We' re just saying they could be a little more aggressive in their DWI work. There's one city in Texas where the police department makes six public in-
toxication arrests for every one DWI arrest. We don't think that's a very good ratio."
Sarpalius also indicated the bill might generate some unexpected benefits for the counties.
"It may take a little money from them at first, but we think it'li give them money in the long run," he
said. "The polioe are going to have an additional incentive to make DWI arrests, which will result in more convictions and more fine

New Law Defines Resident Aliens
In an attempt to eliminate conusion over the income tax status of aliens, the Tax Reform Act of 1984 has provided some specific rules or determination of resident alien January 1, 1985.
Aliens who are lawful, perma ont residents at any time during the vear, or who meet the requirements of the substantial presence lest will be treated as resident aliens, the Internal Revenue Ser vico said. All other aliens will be treated as non-resident aliens. Resident aliens are taxed on world-
wide income, and non-resident wide income, and non-resident
aliens are taxed only on income that is from the United States sources or connected with a United States trade or business.
Lawful, permanent residents have passed the so-called green card test. That is, they have received, and retain, immigrant status with permission to remain in
the U.S. permanently he U.S. permanently.
The substantial presence test is based on presence in the U. S. for
specified periods of time over a three-year period. Students, teachers, and persons related to foreign governments may not qualify for this test. Also, persons with a foreign tax home and close foreign ies will not qualify.
These rules affect These rules affect classification only. They do not affect gift and
ondens for income tax purpose estate tax law or immigration regulations.
