She married B.J. Garnett in 1911, at Jacob's Well in Hays County. He preceeded her death in 1966, and a son, Stanley, died
in 1978.

## Appraisal District hearing

The appraisal review board
(ARB) for Hansford County Appraisal District begins hearing taxpeyer appeels on Tuesday, , aya 18, 183. Property of their property appraisals at any time prior to the date the ARB approves the appraisal records.
The ARB is a group of citizens of the appraisal district who have been appointed by the district directors to equalize property values and consider claims for xemption and agriculurat of the central appraisal district, taxpayers are able to address a single equalization board instead of one for each taxing unit in which their property is located. According to Mrs. Peddy, chief appraiser for the Hensford County Appraisal Distrilct, a property owner may protest any of seven specific actions of any other action that applies to the owner and adversely affects him.
The seven protests are: --the appraised or agricultural value of the property; --unequal appraisel of the taxpayer's property in comparison to the weightd average level of appraisals of district: --inclusion of the proparty on the appraisal records; -denial of a partial exemption, such as a homested exemption; -denial of agricultural-use, open space or timber valuation;-- identification of the taxing unit or units in which the property is located; --determination that the
taxpayer is the owner of the property property
A property owner who wishes or more of these actions must file a written "notice of protest" with the review board, Mrs. Peddy said.

The BB's The Navy decided some years
ago to recommission the New
Jersesy, a World War II battle-
ship. Recently three more were
recalled. These 45,000 ton war-
ships are being modernized with
missiles and missile defenses.
The New Jersey saw service in
Vietnam and off the coast of
Lebanon. The Iowa only recently
joined the fleet. The Missouri was
recently towed out of her
tourist-dock in Bremerton, Wash-
ington to begin her refit.
Wisconsin will be the last of these
ships put back into service.
Cnntroversy still rages over
their vulnerability. But a few
things are clear. They are tougher
than some modern ships, and
heavier. They are a smaller target
than 80,000-ton aircraft carriers.
With adequate air cover, they
should be harder to sink.
Primarily, however, the re-
commissioning is a means of
obtaining a major warship in less
time, at less expense, than if built
from the ground up. No one can
really
be sure of their
comparative vulnerability, or
value. One must hope their pre-
sence will help keep the peace
and that they need never be used.
