So you've decided to sign up for an exercise class, and the que tion is, which one to take? Selecting among exercise claspes is sometimes just a matter of picking the one that meets closest time. However, there are other ime. However, there are other mportant points to consider woll.
For example, you can't always Jadge the quality of an exercise program by the size of the fee charged. Sometimes higher fees simply mean that you're helping to pay for fancy equipment that the class will not use, or a business location in the high-rent district.
If fact, some of the best exercise programs may be available to you through public agencies and service organizaons at very low cost.
The key rule for selecting an exercise program is finding one fitness through appropriate terosic exercise.
So before signing up for any exercise class, ask the following questions. the more "yes" answers you can give, the more likely that the program will help you become more fit.
Are personal health history forms or medical release forms required?
Will you get an individual fitness assessment and evaluation? Do the warm-up and cool-down phases include slow stretching (not bouncing)?

Are five to 15 minutes allowed for werm-up; 20-30 minutes for aerobic conditioning: and five to 15 minutes for cool-down?
Does the instructor explain and follow the aerobic training principles for frequency, intensity time or duration and type of exercise?
Will your individual target heart rate zone be explained established and frequently monitored?
Do instructors watch students close enough to guard against overworking?
If the class meets less than hree times per week less than ambic activities suggested? Amer actiles susgests auch es body composition, diet and weight control discussed factually?
If you aren't physically capable of doing the more demanding exercises, will you be given alternatives?
Does the instructor have a background in physical education, anatomy, physiology, fitness, injury prevention and exercise technique?

## IRA deadline changed

The deadline for IRA (Individual Retirement Account) contributions has been shortened to the April 15 tax filing date. Regarding IRAs, pensions and annuities, heirs have been greater flexibility as to when to take taxable distributions. Also, part of the tax on long-term gains in variable and such annuities will now be able to completely defer long term capital gains until they an paid out to the annuitant.

Some changes also have been made regarding tax credits and depreciaton write-offs for business related use of a personal computer or a car bought after June 18 of this year, notes Stegelin. Hencoforth, the IRS will want proof that a computer is
required for work and that it is required for work and that it is
used for business use more than used for business use more than
50 percent of the time. Regarding 50 percent of the time. Regarding personal cars for business use,
the 6 percent tax credit on cars costing more than $\$ 16,666$ has been reduced, and annual depreabeen reduced, and annual depreo-
iation ceilings have been changed so that the write-off period has been nearly doubled.
