School heads awarded new district court as of presstime

contracts

School administrators within the Spearman ISD were awarded new contracts at the SISD board meeting Tuesday morning.

Receiving 2-year contracts were high school principal Ken Friemal, elemenatary principal, Allen Alford, and business administrator, Orville Latham.

Junior high principal Eddie Gage was given a 1-year contract in order to have contracts for administrators on a staggered year basis.

The Spearman ISD also accepted the resignation of assistant football coach Ken Rutherford. Rutherford has indicated he is seeking a head coaching position outside of Hansford County.

The SISD board also agreed to purchase a tractor for the Spearman Ag Farm at a cost of approximately \$2,500.

move ahead on construction plans for the proposed dam.

That vote came in a Tuesday afternoon meeting where the board's land negotiator reported that he had failed to reach a settlement with Avlin Bushman of Perryton on the land needed for the dam proper.

No suit had been brought to 84th Wednesday, however, and PDRA general manager Johnnie Lee was reported to be meeting with the board's land negotiator in Amarillo at the time in an attempt to reach a settlement.

A time table for the construction of the dam proper leaves the PDRA board in a position of needing to have access to the land in order to begin construction in late spring or early summer.

"This is not something we're wanting to do," notes Ken Evans, cretary of the PDRA board, "But in order to maintain our time schedule, we must move ahead."

They also authorized the general manager to enter into a contract with Natural Gas Pipeline for moving pipeline.

Rotary Club breaks goal in grand manner

The Spearman Rotary Club broke the \$11,000 mark in pledges this week as part of a fund raising effort by Rotary International to help wipe out polio world wide -more than besting a goal of only \$800 set for them by their district office.

The money will be used in countries across the world to help vaccinate children against polio and five other childhood diseases including measles, TB, diphtheria, whooping cough and tetanus.

According to Spearman project chairman Jack McWhirter, each \$1 of pledges will help vaccinate eight children

"People of Spearman have assured that some 88,000 children will receive these immunizations,"

The drive is a long way from over and the Spearman civic club's total was boosted by a single donation of \$5,000 from one resident.

"This project isn't just for Rotary Club members," reports McWhirter. "It's open to every resident of Hansford County who

feels they'd like to participate.' Pledges or donations can be made to any Spearman Rotary Club member or mailed to the club at Box 492 in Spearman.

The campaign -- called PolioPlus by Rotary International -- had already seen the Rotary Foundation make grants totaling over \$40-million by mid-1987.

Hospital in negotiation

Negotiations preparatory to recruit a new physician for Spearman and Hansford County will highlight an otherwise routine agenda for the Hansford County Hospital District this Thursday evening.

That meeting will begin at 7 p.m. in the board room of the Hansford Hospital in Spearman.

In addition, board members will also consider ordering a sheriff's sale on a piece of Hansford County property in order to collect an unpaid debt owed to the hospital.

Board members will also consider entering into an agreement with the Canadian Hospital District to share the expense on a full-time nurse-anesthetist.

"In order to have a qualified person fill this position, we'd be looking at a cost of approximately \$44,000 to \$48,000 annually," notes hospital administrator Al La Rochelle. "By splitting his time between here and Canadian, we can have the benefit of a certified anesthetist at half the price."

Lynx in must-win situation . . .

Lynxettes clinch playoff berth

The Spearman Lynxettes clinched a berth in post-season playoffs with a pair of back-to-back wins this past week while the Lynx fell out of hte driver's seat into a series of must-win situations after dropping their second encounter to the Bucks in White Deer last Friday.

That lone loss -- coupled with a win over West Texas High -- saw the Lynx go to 7-4, just one-half game behind second place Stratford who wound up their regular season Tuesday evening with a strong win over Gruver.

The Elks finished the 1-AA district cager race with an 8-4 mark. This means the Spearman boys must beat Panhandle Friday evening in order to force a tie with Stratford and put the two teams into a playoff to decide who will represent the district as the second place team in post-season playoffs.

This past week, the Lynxettes downed White Deer, 50-16, then came back to defeat West Texas High, 54-30 Tuesday evening in the

The Lynx were tripped up by the Bucks, 54-50, Saturday afternoon in White Deer, but came back to bury the Comanches of West Texas High, 86-68, Tuesday night in

Against White Deer, the Lynxettes were paced by the double point effort of floor leader Krista Kirkland who had 12 points. A total of nine varsity girls got on the scoreboard in that contest.

Three Spearman girls gained double figures against West Texas with Kirkland leading the pack with 21 points.

Londee Bradley had 12 points and Ginger Pearson turned in a strong scoring performance with 11 points of her own. The boys game in White Deer

saw Brett Davis hit for five 3-point shots to claim 15 points and high scoring for Spearman in that loss.

Also in double figures in the Lynx-Buck roundball contest was Tim Woolley with 13.

Against West Texas Tuesday, the Lynx had four men in double figures and a total of 10 players who got on the scoreboard in one of their best team efforts to date.

Davis and Woolley each hit for 17 points apiece to lead the Spearman effort. Carl Urban turned in 15 points while Kevin Nelson dumped in another 13 for Spearman.

Junior varsity action saw the Spearman boys claim a pair of wins while the Lynxette jv crew dropped their contests.

The Lynx jv dropped White Deer by a 40-32 count, then came back to down their West Texas counterparts, 33-25, Tuesday evening.

Mark Garcia hit for 17 points to lead the Lynx jv against White Deer, then came back with a

16-point night against West Texas. On the girls side of the ledger, the Lynxette jv bowed out to White Deer, 28-32, then fell to visiting West Texas, 22-34.

High point against White Deer

was Cindy Melton with eight points while Brandi Schneider hit for seven points to lead the Lynxette jv against West Texas.

naming an interim superintendent, either from within the school system or through the temporary hiring of a retired administrator to fill that gap until a new superin-

A Dalhart assistant-superintendent may have talked with Gruver school officials during their Wednesday meeting concerning the Gruver head administrative position, but that report was unconfirmed at presstime.

First free commodity distribution

While the first surplus commodity distribution will be held at the Hansford County courthouse in Spearman next Wednesday, only 115 of some 225 certified recipients from the 1987 rolls have recertified, reports Donna Yarbrough of the county judge's office.

'People who were certified last year must recertify again this year," notes Yarbrough. "And it would certainly speed things up if they don't wait until distribution day to accomplish that.'

Those who were certified during 1987 are asked to come into the county judge's office and re-certify for this year prior to Wednesday's distribution, she adds. Receipt of surplus commodities

will be slowed down for those who have not already recertified prior to the Wednesday distribution, Yarbrough reports.

Those eligible for surplus com modities include recipients of Aid to Families with Dependent Children, those receiving food stamps, medical assistance only or supplemental security income.

Commodity distribution will be held from 1 to 5 p.m. next


Dear Editor:

Congressmen are destroying our freedoms through their tightening down of the screws on American individualism and accomplishments, through the wrecking of Constitutional Common Laws of Biblical origin.

On May 26, 1987, Justices of the Supreme Court informed the nation that "we are now living in a police state." It is quite a political revelation to read in detail the Supreme Court Opinions on the May 26 preventative detention case. I say opinions because there were three of them: the majority opinion endorsing preventitive detention (representing the view of six justices); and two separate dissenting opinions opposing it (representing the view of the other three justices). Although the massive stone lettering above the entrance to the Supreme Court says "equal justice under law", justice is, in fact, becoming increasingly uncommon in such high locations.

The preventitive detention case called into question the constitutionality of the 1984 Bail Reform Act (18U.S.C.3141 et seq) which passed the U.S. Senate by an overwhelming 96 to 1 vote. Since its passage, approximately 7,000 individuals have been held without bail under the "preventive detention" sections of the Act because the government claimed they represented a future danger to society. This number is likely to grow; and so is plea-bargaining, because (for tactical reasons) overworked prosecutors are using the threat of no bail against arrestees to gain their "cooperation". The message is that trial is an insignificant afterthought. Arrest is given the weight of irrefutable evidence and conviction under this corrupt scheme.

What this means is that the government claims as "future threats' to society (i.e. patriotic Christians, so-called "tax protesters," so called "right-wing extremists," etc.) are to be held without bail and in many cases held

without common law trial when they refuse to enter a plea. So anyone detained in a county jail must enter a "guilty" or "not guilty" of his own accord. To we citizens it sounds like the Supreme Court is right in calling the U.S. a "Police State".

Recently the Boston Globe reported in area newspapers of the FBI conducting a campaign of infiltration and surveillance against hundreds of U.S. political and religious groups opposed to Reagan administration policies in Central America.
