# Lynx quintet named to 1-AA All District

The Spearman Lynx had all five starters named to the 1-AA All District first team or honorable mention squad and Lynx coach H.M. Garrett was named as one of two Coaches of the Year as Spearman dominated listings released this week.

Seniors Carl Urban and Brett Davis gained the All District first team while Tim Woolley, Kevin Nelson and Keith Benson were all named as honorable mention.

No team in district 1-AA got more than two players on the first team all district list. Panhandle and West Texas received three honorable mentions each, but no first team members.

Spearman had five men on the list with two first teamers and three honorable mentions. All the remaining teams had no more than three men each on the two lists.

Gruver placed two men on the first team -- Brian Hoel and Troy Seagler -- with Tim Fletcher garnering honorable mention accolades.

Stratford had two first teamers

and one honorable mention as well with Elk coach Roger Whiteside receiving the other Coach of the Year honor.

Highland Park and White Deer each had three first teamers and one honorable mention on the 1-AA All District listings.

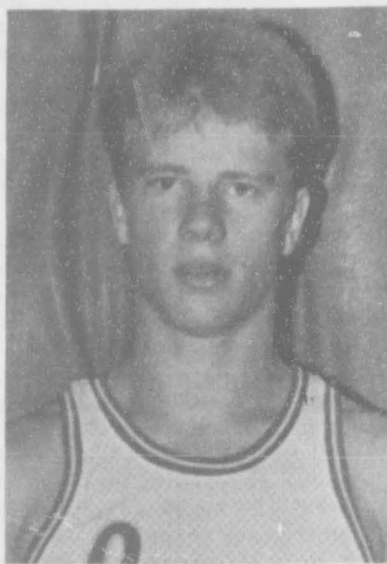
Panhandle and West Texas High each had three honorable mentions from their 1987-88 line up.

## Primary balloting slated Tuesday

Voters in Hansford county and across Texas will go to the polls in both Democratic and Republican presidential preference primaries

### February breaks 24-month string

February broke a 24-month string of moisture making months for Hansford county as only a trace of snow was recorded -- that coming on Feb. 11 -- with no measurable precipitation, according to records at Hansford county's official weather reporting station, KRDF-FM in Spearman.

The last month that went without any measuring precipitation was in January, 1986.

The 1987 total precipitation of 26.7 inches was the largest amount of moisture recorded in the county in the last 10 years.

So far in 1988, only .72 of an inch has been recorded at the Hansford county weather station.

While February began on a cold note -- the first above freezing temperature was not recorded until Feb. 4 with 38 degrees -- it settled into mild afternoon temperatures with cool nights for the most part.

next Tuesday to decide who will represent their respective parties in the November general election.

The count down to 'Super Tuesday' marks the first time that Texas voters have participated in the March primary voting with 19 other Southern states and a large number of delegates are up for grabs in both parties.

Locally, voters will decide on a couple of highly contested races -- most notably that of 84th District Attorney where a 5-candidate field will be narrowed to two after next Tuesday's balloting.

Incumbent Gene Compton is facing challenges from Stephen "Steve" Cross and Phil Black on the Republican ticket. All three men are from Borger.

On the Democratic ticket, John

La Grone and Vance Jones are vying for the right to meet the Republican choice in the general election.

A low-key campaign in Gruver has precinct three county commissioner incumbent B.J. Renner being challenged by Don Evans in the Democratic primary. The win-

ner of this race will be unopposed in the general election.

The 84th District Judge, J.E. Blackwell, is unopposed on the Republican ticket in the primaries, but will face a Democratic challenger this fall in the form of David Wagner of Borger.

## Lynx lose AA bi-district

The Spearman Lynx -- hobbled by injuries to a pair of key players -- saw their season come to an abrupt halt Friday evening in Perryton as the Canadian Wildcats hauled in a 63-54 bi-district win over the district 1-AA champs.

Kevin Nelson, still suffering from an ankle injury against Stratford the week before, and Tim Woolley, who was taken from play in the fourth quarter with severe leg cramps, had to watch from the bench as the Wildcats from 2-AA provided the close to the Spearman cager season.

In the early goings, it began to appear that the night might belong solely to the Wildcats who went out to a 13-4 lead before the Lynx began to find their mark in the opening minutes of the game.

But Spearman came back to hit for 12 points while Canadian managed only two in answer and the Lynx held a slim, 1-point advan-

tage at the close of that first frame, 16-4.

The second period of play saw the Lynx stretch their lead out to five as Spearman hit for 15 points while limiting their Canadian counterparts to only 11.

As the buzzer sounded ending the first half of bi-district action, Spearman was in command of a 31-26 lead.

Canadian wasn't about to give up, however, and used the third quarter to tie things up at 42-ALL.

Then, with Benson already on the bench Woolley found himself the victim of leg cramps and, only minutes into the final frame, the veteran Lynx performer was on the sidelines.

The Wildcats managed to connect for 21 points in that final eight minutes of play while the Lynx could manage only 12 points of their own as the Wildcats took the win, 63-54.

The Lynx put three men in double figures with Carl Urban leading the pack with 14 points. Woolley -- despite his early departure -- finished the night with 13 points. Also in double figures was Davis with 11 points.

The Spearman Lynx cager crew finished the season with a 20-10 record and as the district 1-AA championship team.

Tim Woolley, Carl Urban, Kevin Nelson, Keith Benson and Brett Davis provided Spearman fans with a full season of court heroics this season.

Shawn Cook will be in the pole vault and the 100 and 200 meter runs for Spearman at the Perryton track meet.

Mark Garcia and Norman Scroggs will be testing their talents in the 800-meter run while Jerald Blan and Lester Sullivan both run the 1600-meter and 3200-meter distance events.

In junior varsity, Chris Williamson, Allen Howell, Temp Sheppard and Edgar Nava will make up

the Spearman 400 and 1600-meter relay squads.

In addition, Williamson will also run the 110-meter high hurdles while Howell takes part in the 100-meter dash.

Sheppard will run either the 100

or 200 meter dash while Nava takes part in the 400-meter run.

Other jv'ers running Saturday will be Lee Villareal in the 1600 and 3200-meter distance runs with Danny Lopez running both the 110 high and 300-meter intermediate hurdles.

already have 176 booked.

There are entries from River Road, Quannah, Channing, Amarillo, Tascosa, Dumas, Amherst, Gruver, Clayton, Floydada;

Canyon, Felts, McLean Merritt, Pampa, Hereford, Wheeler, Adrian, Spearman, Elk City, Follett and Perryton.

The Spearman-Gruver TSHSRA rodeo marks the first of a busy spring schedule which will have high school rodeos every weekend through May 7.

The Tri-State High School Rodeo Association finals will be held June 9-10-11 in either Amarillo or Dumas.

Only the top 15 contenders for top rankings in each of the six boys events and each of the four girls events will make the TSHSRA finals.

Children will be admitted free to this weekend's Spearman-Gruver TSHSRA rodeo when accompanied by an adult. Free children's passes are available at the Spearman Reporter office in Spearman.

Events for boys include bareback bronc riding, calf roping, steer wrestling, bull riding, team roping and ribbon roping.

Girls events are barrel racing, goat tying, breakaway roping and pole bending.

## PRIMARY

Other county offices open for election have all incumbents running unopposed in their respective primaries.

County attorney John Hutchison is running on the Republican ticket while all other incumbents are seeking re-election on the Democratic ballot.

Those include Garland Head, county commissioner precinct one; Helen Dry, county tax assessor-collector and R.L. McFarlin, sheriff.

Ernie Vanderburg has filed intentions to run for the county commissioner's precinct one post in a write in campaign this fall, however.

Vanderburg had originally filed by petition on the Republican party primary ballot, but was forced to withdraw his name when a canvas of names failed to give him the needed 50 registered voters from precinct one on the petition.

He later decided to continue his campaign on a write in basis and has filed that intent with the Hansford county judge.

Current U.S. Representative Beau Boulter will be seeking the Republican nomination for U.S. Senate in the primaries in an attempt to unseat Democratic Senator Lloyd Bentsen this fall.

His decision to run for senate leaves his house seat up for grabs and a long list of candidates in both parties are vying for that.

Republicans include Jim Brandon, an Amarillo businessman; Ron Buffum, a Wichita Falls oilman; Larry Milner, president of the Amarillo chamber of commerce;

Alan Pickering, a Church of Christ minister from Amarillo; Bob Price, a Pampa farmer-rancher who held that seat from 1967 to 1975; and state representative Chip Staniswalis of Amarillo.

On the Democratic ticket, Floyd county district attorney John Randolph Hollums has filed for that same seat along with Vernon businessman Ed Lehman and current state senator, Bill Sarpauius.

Political hopefuls for the 31st state senator's seat includes Ron Slover and Teel Bivins, both of Amarillo, for the Republican nomination.

On the Democratic side of the 2-party ticket, former 47th district judge H. Bryan Poff, along with Amarillo attorney Nancy Garms and Democratic party activist Mel Phillips of Amarillo are seeking the
