

# 7 SHS athletes claim berths to AA regionals

A total of seven Spearman Lynx and Lynxette track and field standouts captured berths to the regional track meet in 13 different events, giving Spearman high school one of the larger slates of candidates in district 1-AA.

Leading the field for Spearman was junior Heather Murrell who claimed first place finishes in four separate events.

The state-performer won the long jump, the 100-meter hurdles, the 400 and 200 meter runs at the district 1-AA meet held in White Deer this past weekend.

Other multi-event district performers were Krista Kirkland, Matt Tucker and Jerold Blan, each gaining berths to regionals in two events apiece.

Kirkland will be going in the 3200 and 1600-meter runs while Tucker gained his berth in the discus and shot put. Blan will be mpeting in the 3200 and 1600handle won there with 124 points, followed by West Texas with 109 and White Deer with 79.

Murrell's performances saw her take the long jump with a leap of 17-11/2; the 100-meter hurdles event in 14.8 second, the 400-meter run in a time of 58.04 and the 200-meter run with a time of 26.04. Kirkland won the 1600-meter run

with a time of 5:48.9 and was second in the 3200-meter run with a time of 12:58.96.

Tucker's heft of 154-03/4 won the discus event and his put of 52-71/2 claimed first in the shot.

Blan ran off a 4:49.57 time in the 1600-meter event to win there, then he claimed the 3200-meter run with a time of 10:41.37.

Lance Swan was second in the discus with a toss of 140-7 while Laci Lasater was second in the triple jump with a combined total of 32-10 1/2 .

# **Cities in favor of PDRA proposal**

Five of six cities in the Palo Duro River Authority have given an "expression of intent" to shoulder a portion of the \$3.2-million shortage in construction financing for a Palo Duro Creek dam project.

The lone hold out at presstime was the city of Cactus in Moore

The lone hold out at presstime was the city of Cactus in Moore county. That community is currently paying off a bond on their current water system.

"We're not real favorable (on the PDRA proposal) at this time." notes Cactus mayor Leon Graham. "We're already paying over \$100,000 a year on our current water system."

To help pay \$3.2-million cost over run ...

Inder the proposal, Dumas would shoulder the largest portion of the debt repayment followed by Spearman, Sunray, Stinnett, Gruver and Cactus.

Under this proposal, the large meat packing plant served by Cactus would be eliminated from receiving any water from the Hansford county based dam.

The 25-year repayment schedule calls for a set figure for the first 10 years with higher payments in the final 15 years.

Dumas' portion would be

would escalate to \$192,014 for the final 15 years.

Spearman's share would run \$47,120 for the first 10 years and \$63,055 for the last 15 years of the plan

Gruver's segment would be \$19,000 for the first 10 years and \$25,000 for the final 15 years of the repayment.

Average prices in the six PDRA communities would translate into \$2.53 per customer per month for the first 10 years and \$3.39 per customer per month for the final 15 years.

Other cities shares would have Stinnett paying \$28,971 and \$38,769; Sunray paying \$25,050 and\$33,521; Cactus paying \$11,370

The proposition for the \$3.2-million in additional financing needed for the dam construction was advanced by Pete Tart of Dallas, bond attorney for the authority, and one of the financial advisors Kent Smith, a representative of Southwestern Security of Dallas. In essence, the six cities will pay

for construction of the intake system for a water treatment plant near the Palo Duro Creek dam. The intake will be built with the

For city, school elections in 3 communities ... Active campaigns mark elections

Several active campaigns in Hansford county may have absentee balloting remaining steady for both school and city elections in the three communities located within the county.

Absentee balloting for the May 7 city and school board elections will run through Tuesday, May 3 with voters who will be out of town during the regular election day able to cast their ballot at the respective political subdivisions main office anytime during the week through the May 3 deadline.

There are contested races in Spearman, Gruver and Pringle-Morse for elections to be held there.

Spearman will be choosing a new mayor and two new councilmembers while Gruver selects a new councilmember and two new school board members. Pringle Morse will be electing two new school board members.

Spearman has two men vying for mayor. Bob Pearson, an oil and gas attorney, was the first too file. Burl Buchanan, a Spearman insurance agent who is currently serving as a

councilmember on the Spearman city board, also announced as a mayoral candidate.

In the councilmember race at Spearman, four men are seeking two seats there.

Don Reed, who is employed by Transpetco; Lenis Simpson, an employee of B&B Farm Industries; Bob Boxwell, owner/operator of Boxwell Brothers Funeral Directors; and Harry Stumpf, a retiree, make up the list of candidates there.

Two incumbents, Mike Garnett and Joe Clement, are running unopposed for the Spearman ISD board.

In Gruver, a full slate of candidates for both city and school elections are on the ballots there.

For the city council seat, Larry Lewallen, an employee of Caprock Industries, and Andrea Bayless, a Gruver high school teacher, will have their names on the ballot.

A total of five people are seeking two places on the GISD board of trustees. Both incumbents chose not to run for re-election in 1988. That field includes Ray Etheredge, Lonnie Hiller, Larry Babbs, J.W. Ward and Tommy Gumfory compose that list.

Ward and Hiller are both involved in farming while Etheredge is employed by Caprock Industries. Babbs owns and operates his own welding shop and Gumfory is an attorney.

At Pringle-Morse, a field of four are running for a pair of PMCISD trustee seats which are being vacated by two retiring school board members.

Incumbents Dub Womble and Allen McCloy chose not to run for re-election to the 3-year terms.

There Ron Womble, Alan Shields, Betty Womble and Randy Reid are running for the two places open.

Ron is a cousin of retiring trustee Dub Womble. Betty is the wife of Dub.

Ron is an employee of Morse Oil while Shields and Reid are farmers in the Pringle-Morse vicinity. Betty is a housewife.

Hansford county moisture totals got a boost this past weekend with a 2-day rain which added another 2.22 inches to an already waterlogged area.

That moisture brings the total through April to 2.89 inches for the month and put 1988 well ahead of last year's record-setting precipitation pace.

Through the same time period in 1987, moisture totals stood at 4.73 inches for the year. Totals this year amount to 6.08 inches of moisture according to the official Hansford county reporting station, KRDF-FM in Spearman.

April last year, however, had only .48 of an inch of moisture with May and June providing over four and five inches each of those two months.

lizards." After that, we had bowls of blackeyed peas, cornbread, sowbelly, hog jowl, ridgerunner roast, and half-a-calf spare ribs. I waddled out like a rhinocerous wearing leg irons.

dam to save on construction costs. The treatment plant and a distribution pipeline will be built in the future when the six member cities need additional water supplies.

Tart and Smith explained that the funding would be provided through installment purchase agreements with each city for an interest in the treatment plant intake system.

"Each contract will stand on its own," Tart emphasized. "If one of the cities failed to make a payment, the contract would state that the other members were not liable for the debt.'

On the strength of the contracts. bonds would be issued by the Texas Water Development Board for the \$3.2-million in additional financing.

The debt would be a 25-year obligation with an average interest rate of 8.2 percent. Repayment by the cities would be made directly to the state agency.

Total payment for the first 10 years by member cities would amount to \$275,000 annually with \$368,000 per year for the final 15 years.


The two financial representatives noted that repayment by the cities could be accomplished either through ad valorem taxes or surpluses from city utility systems.

City officials, primarily Spearman mayor Ralph Blodgett, questioned PDRA representatives closely on the financing plan and reasons why the dam construction project had overrun engineering and archaelological survey estimates.

The construction bid came in at \$2.3-million over budget while the archeological survey now stands at \$900,000 over the original \$100,000 budgeted for the survey.

"We can live with it (the repayment schedule) as long as it's fair and equitable for all parties," declared Blodgett, to conclude the 3-hour meeting.

works are eligible for renewal. Over the course of the four-year program, grants are expected to average \$650,000. Each group of hospitals also is eligible to apply to the foundation for up to \$500,000 in low-interest loans to help upgrade or expend its services in rural areas.

"Rural hospitals are a vital part of their communities," said Cluff. 'The grants will help them work together to expand their revenue bases, become more cost efficient, recruit physicians and staff, and improve the quality of care they provide.'

West Texas Rural Health Providers will use the funds to develop and implement a computerized management information system to help hospitals plan more efficient and cost effective operations. It also will develop rehabilitation units and nutrition and fitness programs at some member hospitals. The organization is located in Lubbock and its President is Gordon Russell, Administrator of Hi Plains Hospital in Hale Center.

In Spearman we can expect to see initial efforts directed to developing a Peer Support program. This program will allow teams and experts to visit among the various hospitals sharing valuable information and management successes.

Directed by Anthony Kovner, PhD, a professor at the New York University Graduate School of Public Administration, the national program also includes projects in: Eutaw, Ala.; Decorah, Iowa; Portland, Maine; Presque Isle, Maine; Tupelo, Miss.; Springfield, Mo.; Havre, Mont.; Reno, Nev.; Albany, N.Y.; Raleigh, N.C.; West Columbia, S.C.; and Prarie du Sac, Wis.
