The premium is about one-third the cost of this protection. The Federal Government pays the remainder from general revenues.

Hospital insurance protection is extended without premium charge to people 65 and over who are eligible for socall security benefits, to disabled people under 65 who have been entitled to social security disability benefits for 24 consecutive months or more, and to many people under 65 with premanent kidney failure.

"People 65 and over who aren't eligible for social security benefits can get Medicare hospital insurance by paying a monthly premium if they also sign up for the medical insurance," Weatherly said.

The hospital insurance premium rate is based on the average monthly cost of this protection. Starting July 1, this rate will go from \$45 to \$554 a month

#### Technology To Improve Pollination

Modern technology hay yet to improve on Nature' way of cross pollination. Growers of squash, custum ber, cantaloupe, watermelor and pumpkin especially know this, but some still fall to make sure Mother Nature has plenty of honeybeen can do the cross pollination by hand, but commercia growers depend on availabil tiv of bees.

Wild and domestic honeybees are the vital link in the pollination process. When growers and gardeners leave pollination to chance they are very often disappointed when fruit fails to form on their plants.

There are several reasons for failure of fruit to form. Members of the vine crop family have male and female blossoms which develop separately on the plant. Pollen must be physically transfer-red from the male blossom to the female blossom so that polliantion and fruit enlargement can occur. For instance, when bees do not find squash plants and are unable to pollimate the blossoms, the plants will produce many this yquash, but thesety

The home gardener ca easily conduct the pollination process by transferring the oms to the female blossoms.
Blossoms of these plants are pe for only one day, and it is est to conduct pollination in the morning when the new lossom opens. Wilted blosms or those with closed teals will not be affected in collination.

Pollination failure can be much more serious for commercial growers. In North-west Texas, here are over 9,000 acres of crops consisting mainly of cucumbers, squash, cantaloupe and watermelon with an estimated farm value of over \$6 million. 


