

## Agriculture School Shows Growth

Aggie Faculty Busy

The staff of the School of Agriculture is very busy and the prospects for this part of Tech college for the current year are extremely encouraging. In fact, the number of students is such as to indicate that not very many more could be handled at this time.

No undue crowding exists, and the work of instruction is moving along in discussing the School of Agriculture, dean Ledleigh says that there is a 70 per cent increase in the enrollment this fall. It was originally planned to add one man to the Agricultural faculty but it has been necessary to add an additional three employees to fully care for the demands of the students. Associate professor It. C. Mower, was added to the faculty last summer, being assigned to the department of Annal Husbandry for this term in the junior course in Animal Anatomy. One student assistant is employed in the department of Agronomy and one in the department of animal husbandry.



The greatest need in both the departments of Horticulture and to Azronomy, has been laboratory space and facilities. This will be adequately cared for this year by the leasing of green house space in a commerciagreen house just off the college campus, and the courses given will be fully up to standard. It is hoped that if green house will be available on the course the course are of-

Last year the Agriculauril students were almost wholly freshmen and only four different courses were given in the fall term. This year there are freshmen, sophomore and junior classes and eight different subjects are being taught. It appears that next fall, on account of all four years' work being required, about fifteen subjects will be offered.

The registration in the School of Agriculture in the fall term this year as compared to the fall term of hast year, has increased from 60 to 101; furthermore, this is 19 more than was registered in Agriculture during the whole year last year. There are students from 54 different counties in the state and every part of the state represented. There are only two students from outside of Texas. There are students from counties which hogler New Mexico on the South and on the East, students from the north-ern counties of the Panhandle, students

from 5 of the 11 counties that border Red River and one student each from Panola county, which joins Louisiana, i Hidalgo county, of the lower Rio Grande and Nueces county, which is

on the lower Gult Coast. Seven bleekland counties have sent 13 students. About these-fourths of the Agricultural students come from the Wattern one-half of Texas. In this respect, as was the case last year, the students come from a much more widely scattered territory than is usual in most institutions, only about 25 per cent being from homes within a radius of 50 miles of the college.

Men registered in the different courses in the school of exciculture have indicated their preference for major lines of work in which they are interested, and this shows that while animal hubandly is elected more than 1549 other of the four year courses, there are, nevertheless, a considerable number of men who will specialize in Horticulture, Landscape art, agronomy, agricultural education, dairy products, poultry and agricultural machinety.

In keeping with the initial appropriations of the legislature in starting the agricultural work of the Tech college, emphasis was placed on anima hydrody. To deadon this dearest

In horticultural instruction, dry lane and irrigated phases of the industry are, being featured for advanced work The elementary instruction in this department begins in the sophomory year. A large demand exists for courses ig Floriculture and for land-scaping as applied to Western conditions.

In the department of agronomy, elementary survey courses are required in the freshman year and no work is offered to the sophomores. After the sophomore year, all students take work in this department regularly.
