





# Presidents Leave Outstanding Record

Tech's Development Since 1925 **Exhibits Definite Progress** 

SINCE Tech first opened its doors in September 1925, with the largest initial enrollment of any college in the United States, the college's four presidents have in turn directed their energies and abilities toward making it an outstanding educational center for the Southwest.

In November 1923, Dr. Paul Whitfield Horn was elected president of the yet unborn Texas Technological college, and almost immediately afterward he swa the order gived the committee of swappen and the properties of more than a million dollars worth of buildings was not determined until a plan had been made showing all the buildings which would be needed in the next fifty years.


