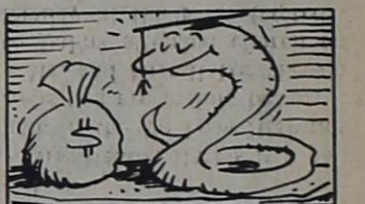
Dewitt Robinett and girls of Clyde visited with Pug and Vonnie Guthery over the week end.
