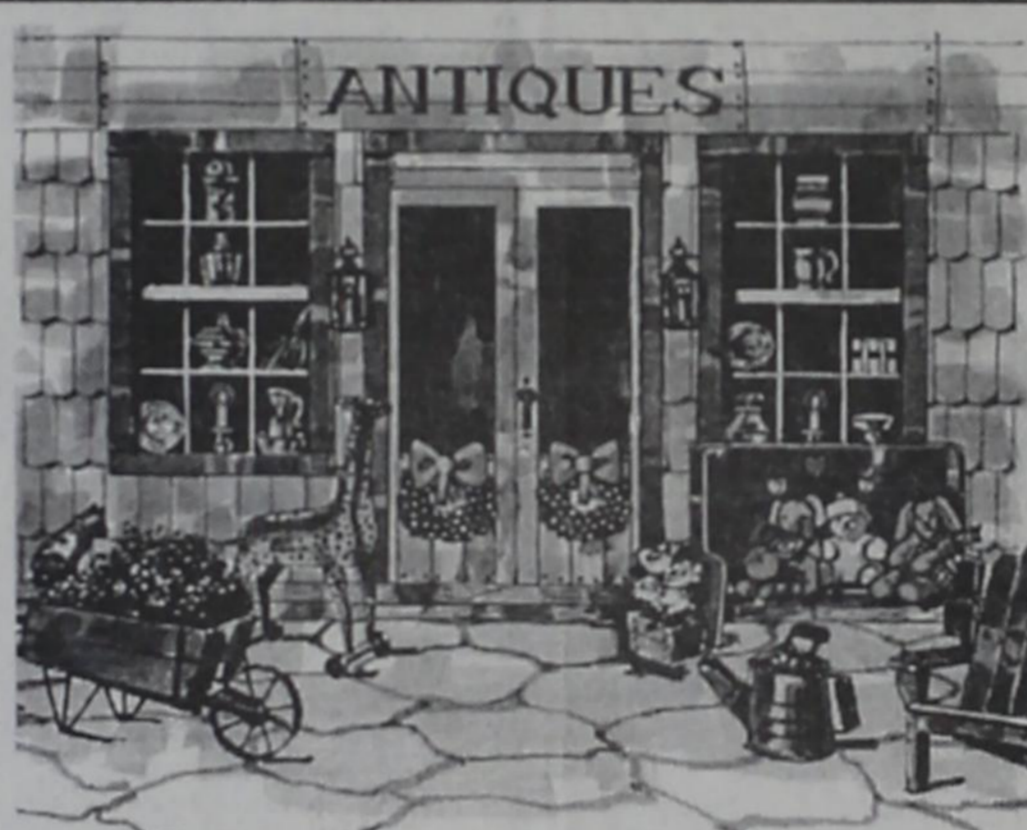

Just a reminder to all dog owners. If you own a dog and it does not have city tags or its rabies vaccination tag you need to get them. You can get your city tags at City Hall. The city tags are \$6 and renewals are \$2. If your dog has not had a rabies vaccination shot you can take them to Dr. Burke in DeLeon to get one. Dr. Burke will charge \$8 for a rabies shot. If you do not have tags for your dogs be sure that you put them on their collar. If your dog is picked up and they do not have any tags the City has no way of knowing who the dog belongs to. If a dog is picked up it will cost \$20 for impound fee, \$6 per day the dog is in animal shelter, plus city tags if it does not have them. You may also receive a citation for your dog running at large along with the above fines. If your dog is picked up by the City it will be held at the animal shelter for three days and it will be euthanized on the fourth day. If you are walking your dog be sure it is on a leash. For you few that are not complying with the city ordinance on dogs make it easy on yourself and the City, get your proper tags for your dogs and keep them either in the fence, on a chain, or in the house. We do not need your dog or any dog getting off of the chain or out of the fence and biting a small child, an adult, or another animal. If your dog bites another person or animal you can be held liable in civil court. If anyone has a dog they do not want, the City will euthanize it for you for \$25.
