

ADVANTAGES OF FUEL OIL RECOGNIZED.

Almost five million more barrels of gas oil and fuel oil were used in our country in 1927 than in 1926, according to a recent report of the bureau of mines of the department of commerce. The largest increase was in the field of domestic heating for homes; 6,-377,479 barrels being used last year and only 2,905,401 barrels in 1926. Heating of office buildings, apartments, schools, hotels, hospitals and other buildings required 15,153,245 barrels in 1927, against 13,874,479 barrels in 1926.

Preceding figures do not include furnace oils and lighter distillates for domestic heating. It is estimated such oils approximated 6,000,000 barrels, which would bring the total amount of oil used in heating buildings to 27,520,000 barrels in 1927, compared with DRAMATIC DIRECTOR 22,780,00 barrels in 1926.






