The prospector is A. R. Aphel, who threatens to tie knots in the policies of the Standard Oil company in the southwestern field. He is president of the Standard Oil company of Ar- kansas, but he is not aligned with the Rockefeller interest. <br> Riding into El Dorado on the recent "boom," Aphel discovered that the Arkansas corporation laws offered no barrier to the use of the incorporated name of another comprany.
