DE VALERA ARRESTED BY FREE STATE TROOPS

ENNIS, County Clare, Ireland, Aug. 15.—Edmond DeValera, republican leader, was arrested by Free State troops today, after he appeared to address a republican meeting in the election campaign.

The arrest was made under sensational circumstances. De Valera was addressing a meeting of electors when Free State troops fired a volley over the heads of the crowd, which stampeded.

The troops surrounded the platform and took the republican leader into custody. The crowd stampeded into all directions. The great gathering became panic stricken as the shots were fired. Women fainted. It was reported that a number of people were wounded. De Valera was taken to jail.
