

#### Home valuations increase 15 percent



A watermelon feed will be held for residents in September, with the date to be determined. The Kalbas family usually donates the melons.



"You must be on time or you will not be judged," alerted Mrs. Moss.


She added, "Contestants need to be sure to stick to the theme - "Real Heroes" - if they are going to be counted. The judges will be looking for adherence to the theme."



The program is only open to students who try out on All-State music pieces on their favorite instrument.


Juan Carlos used the trumpet and was one of 10 accepted. The other nine students were from 5A schools.







futures & options trading by Bryon Fillpot



Live Cattle: Cash trade is expected to trade \$1 lower this week and futures prices have been somewhat reluctant to confirm a turn back up. We have been looking for a bottom around mid July and still lean this direction. A move up into early August would probably catch a long term top which may hold into later this year. The August contract needs a close above \$85 to turn higher.

Feeders: The market continues to follow along behind fed cattle prices. The last couple of weeks have been volatile as cash trade has seen some fairly large swings this week. The market has probably topped but I would continue to look for a retest of contract highs around the \$118.00 level basis the August contract. Should pull higher into early August.

Corn: The market has rallied in a normal seasonal fashion and should be close to making an important top around these levels. The weather has helped to support this move up and the fact that prices normally top around mid July and then move lower into the September time frame. The heat predicted to cover parts of the Corn Belt could support prices for a couple more days?

Soybeans: Prices continue to trade sideways to lower which is a normal tendency from mid July into the September/October time frame. Weather has helped to support prices to some extent, but overall, expect softer prices in coming weeks.

Wheat: The market basically topped on the KC and Chicago Wheat contracts last week after trading and stopping at major resistance levels. Prices have a very strong tendency to bottom during harvest and those years in which prices are trading at historically high levels, expect a top as we move into harvest? Short and long term trends are pointed lower.

Cotton: The market has remained erratic over the last few weeks with crop conditions swings from both sides of the pendulum. Weather in China and Australia have both changing along with weather across the US. This weeks estimates for the crop in good to excellent categories was inchanged. Demand is still expected to remain strong while trends are still pointed down at this time.



#### Hot temperatures return

From Monti Vandiver, Parmer County extension agent-IPM:

Hot temperatures have returned to the Northwest Plains, ramping up moisture requirements of area crops.

Recent rains have been a huge benefit, and in some cases, may have saved a crop. Heat unit accumulations are well above last year and the long term average, but many of the area crops do not appear to be ahead of normal development. This is likely due to very dry and windy conditions limiting the crop's ability to utilize the abundant solar energy.

Spider mites continue to persist in some area cornfields while others are relatively mite free. Corn should be regularly monitored for mite infestation.



The Office of the Superintendent has a copy of the policy which may be reviewed by any interested party.

The household size and income criteria identified below will be used to determine eligibility for free and reduced price benefits. Children from households whose income is at or below the levels shown are eligible for free or reduced-price meals. Foster children who are the legal responsibility of a welfare agency or court may also be eligible for benefits regardless of the income of the household with whom they reside. Eligibility for the foster child is based on the child's income

Application forms are being distributed to all households with a letter informing households of the availability of free and reduced price meals for their children. Applications also are available at the principal's office in each school. To apply for free and reduced price meals, households must fill out the application and return it to the school. Applications may be submitted anytime during the school year. The information households, provide on the application will be used for the purpose of determining eligibility and verification of data. Applications may be verified by school officials at any time during the school year.

For school officials to determine eligibility for free and reduced price benefits, households receiving food stamps or TANF only have to list their child's name, food stamp or TANF case number. An adult household member must sign the application.

Households who do not list a food stamp number or TANF case number must list the names of all household members, the amount and source of the income received by each household member, and the social security number of the adult household member who signs the application. If the adult who signs the application does not have a social security number, the household member must indicate that a social security number is not available by writing the word "none". The application must be signed by an adult household member.

Under the provisions of the free and reduced price meal policy the school secretary will review applications and determine eligibility. Parents or guardians dissatisfied with the ruling of the official may wish to discuss the decision with the reviewing official on an informal basis. Parents wishing to make a formal appeal for a hearing on the decision may make a request either orally or in writing to Bill Bizzell, Supt., P.O. Box 70, Bovina, TX, (806) 251-1336.

Households that list a food stamp or TANF case number must report when the household no longer receives these benefits. Also, if a household member becomes unemployed or if the household size increases, the household should contact the school. Such changes may make the children of the household eligible for benefits if the household's income falls at or below the levels shown above.

# PRPC receives 911 complaints from Bovina

Bovina City Manager such equipment. Ernest Terry last week fired off an angry E-mail to Nielsen, **Panhandle** Regional **Planning** Commission (PRPC) 911 coordinator.

Terry said Bovina sees a need for a change in the current way the community is served by the 911 sys-

The county's 911 system came under attack three vears ago after the death of a Lazbuddie man. Now. a problem has emerged again.

The investigation by the PRPC after the Magy incident basically showed that communications equipment improvements were needed.

In July of 2003. Dovle and Debbie Weir, representing the Lazbuddie EMS, and representatives of West Texas Services. met with the Parmer **County Commissioners to** present a proposal for a repeated for Friona and Muleshoe control stations and paging systems that would allow direct paging to the Lazbuddie EMS personnel.

commissioners then spent \$21,000 on

Also as part of the follow-up to the Lazbuddie case, the PRPC asked the various county governmental entities for any suggestions to improve the 911 paging.

"This week, we had several 911 calls that were taken by Friona, and Friona transferred the calls to Farwell for dispatching," wrote Terry. "This is fire, EMS and police calls. A good example was a call from Jake Steelman, who had cut an artery in his arm and was bleeding to death. He called 911. He was four miles south of Bovina on

"Friona delayed the call by 5 minutes by transferring the call to Farwell. Friona was on the phone with Jake and relaying the fragmented info to Farwell to relay over the radio..."

Terry went on to say that a 5-minute delay could cost an injured person his or her life sometimes.

Terry cited another example of Bovina's problem with 911. This concerned a call from South 1731 that turned out to be

kids playing with a phone. But when Friona got the call, they didn't dispatch it to Bovina. Instead, Terry said they transferred it to Farwell, who dispatched it to the county deputies.

"What is it going to take before someone wakes up? Which is more important, politics or someone's life?" asked Terry.

Other complaints involved Bovina callers to 911 who were put on hold.

The 911 dispatchers in Parmer County work for the Friona police department. Financial aid is given by the county and the PRPC to Friona.

Asked to comment on Terry's E-mail, Ms. Nielsen said on July 13 that she plans to look into it.

Some feel that the 911 system should be under the county's auspices, and that Parmer County Sheriff Randy Geries should be in

charge of it.

Contacted about Terry's E-mail, Geries acknowledged that there are problems in the current system. "There are some inconsistencies and some delay," he said.

Geries said it is feasible for the 911 system to be put under the sheriff's department but that the decision is up to the **Parmer** County Commissioners.

Geries, a Friona resident who served as Friona police chief before becoming county sheriff, doesn't plan to push the project.

Friona Police Chief Tino Salinaz was on vacation and unavailable for comment.

Parmer County Judge Bonnie Heald, who is the presiding officer of the commissioners court, said on Monday that the Ms.

-- Reviewed the 2007 budget.


-- Voted 3-2 to allow Saul Marinelarena keep horses on his property within the
