The Farwell School Board proposed to reduce the tax rate for the coming school year on Tuesday night.

The tax rate is proposed at \$1.0932, down from \$1.1031. The proposed budget is \$5,186,364, which is around \$290,000 higher than the current budget.

Farwell finished the last school year with an average daily attendance (ADA) of 501. Most state funds funneled to schools are based on ADA. The previous year's ADA was 459.

In other business, the board:

- Heard that all three school campuses were qualified as 'recognized' based on TAKS scores from last year. The overall rating for the school was 'academically acceptable.3
- Approved changes to the student handbook. Students must be enrolled at Farwell for 4 semesters in order to be eligible for Mr. and Mrs. FHS.
- **Changed Junior High and High School policy to** ban hats and caps during school hours and set guidelines for attire during prom and graduation.
- Hired Sandy Fuentes as the new Elementary School English as a Second Language teacher.







We next found our bathroom. Key word is bathroom, not bathrooms. There were approximately 18 girls in one hallway, and we all shared one bathroom.

This bathroom only had two showers; you can imagine how long it took for 18 girls to take showers.
