## Texico bull rider turns 18, turns pro and wins 1st event

Eighteen years is a significant amount of time. But for parents, this time usually goes by way to fast. Sandy Bowers of Texico has watched her son, L.J. Jenkins, grow up to make quite a name for himself at only 18 years old.

L.J. is a professional bull rider. Within the last month, he has accomplished 3rd at the National High School Rodeo Finals, 1st in a Professional Bull Riders (PBR) competition in Gillette, Wyo., and 2nd at another PBR in a Montana town.

I got to sit down with L.J. and talk with him a little about himself, what he does (I know nothing about bull riding), and his accomplishments. He was

very humble and not too proud of himself, though his mother put in a good word here and there.

L.J. first got interested in bull riding when he was about six. His dad, Larry Jenkins, rode professionally. It immediately interested L.J. "Bull riding ran in the family, I always wanted to ride."

Though he was interested in riding at a very young age, he did all the activities every young child did in their youth. He played soccer, baseball, and basketball. "I guess I was pretty good," he said. "At least my mom says I was."

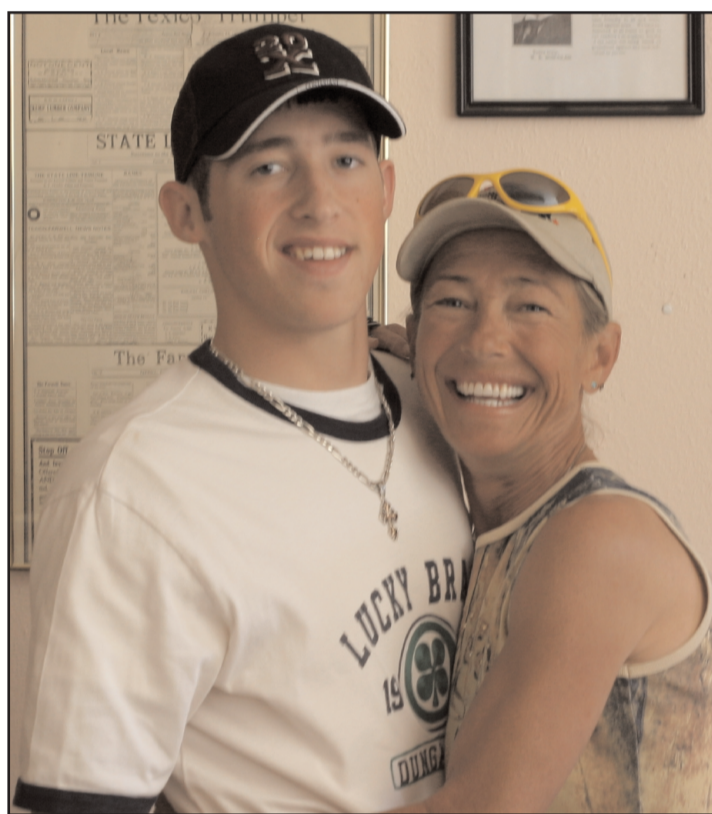
Well, maybe playing all those sports as a child whipped L.J. into shape for riding. He doesn't really work out that much. "I'm somewhat fit," he said. "Riding pretty much get me in shape itself."

You might be thinking that all of these events might interfere with school, but L.J. has done very well. As he recalls, he has around a 3.8 grade point average, while doing the best he can during riding. He and his family are working and trying to figure out the school year and let him keep doing what he loves. L.J. said they'll pretty much take everything day by day.

Speaking of school, due to L.J.'s success, he has been given many offers by colleges to go and ride. He has many options and his accomplishments have given him many scholarship opportunities. "I don't know where I'll go, or what I'll do, but I do know that I want to ride professionally for a long time."

At the High School Nationals, L.J. competed against about 200 other students that were also bull riders. They each got two days to ride, and the top 20 with the

best scores, advanced to the finals. L.J. received third after tackling the best bulls at the competition.

On July 17, L.J. turned 18. Now, he could compete professionally. He competed in a PBR in Gillette and won first, earning \$9,000.

Next, he drove 4 hours to a Montana town, and won second, earning \$4,000. The one rider that beat him is ranked second in the world.

Scholarships are pretty much for the winners of high school competitions, but now that L.J. is a member of the Professional Bull Riders Association, he is making the "big bucks." He has already won over \$17,000 because of his placing in his ridings.

What does he do with all of his earnings? Well, it does take quite a bit of money to travel to all of the different events. "This weekend will cost me about \$1,000 and entry fees are usually \$250 or higher." But, L.J.'s got it covered. If he keeps doing as well as he has, money will not be a problem. He had to buy his PBR permit and he just bought a brand new Ford pickup.

L.J. is currently ranked 54th in the world (after being a professional for less than a month!). For an 18-year-old, that's pretty darn good. He's only 9 spots out of being in the world championships.

The top 45 bull riders in the world compete in the world finals in Las Vegas to compete for over \$3 million in prize money. L.J. looks up to the men in the top 10. "It feels good to be ranked 54th," he said. "But I want nothing more than to go to the world finals."

L.J.'s not that far out of being right up there. Riders are ranked by the amount of money they have earned, and as of right now he's \$8,000 out of the top 45.

So, how does one ride a bull? L.J. said, "I ride on balance." He's been to a bull riding school four or five times in Missouri with some of the best riders in the world. He was only 12 years old when he first went, but he must have learned an awful lot. It proves true in his riding today.

By sitting with L.J., I could tell he had good confidence. "It feels good to ride bulls," he said. "It's in my blood."

Now you can't expect to ride a bull without getting hurt sometimes. L.J. has quite a list growing of injuries ... He has a metal rod in his leg and he's broken the bones in his chins and his left arm, he's had stitches in his mouth, and had some teeth knocked out. "The thing that makes riding difficult," L.J. said, "is that you know you would die. It's a great risk."

Eight seconds isn't that long of a time. But when you're riding a bull, time is completely different. "When I ride, my mind goes blank. I just listen for the whistle. When I start to think, that's when it's all over."

L.J. does still get a little nervous before he rides. He said he realizes that he's riding pro and there's a lot of money out there at stake.

He doesn't really have a routine or anything to psych himself up, but before every ride "I do drink a Red Bull," he said of the energy drink. Whatever he's doin', it must be working because great things have happened so far for this young man.

He has a long road ahead of him. "I've been on the road all my life," he said, so he's no stranger to not being home very often. He's got events going from Amarillo to North Carolina to New York all in three days! "I'm never home," he said, and his mom agreed.

L.J. wanted to take this opportunity to thank his community for all of their prayers and support. He also wants to thank his stepdad, Jay Bowers, for getting him to Gillette. He almost didn't make it to that event, but thanks to Jay, L.J. finally got a start in his career of bull riding.

With the way things are going, keep a watchful eye this October for the bull riding world championships, L.J. has a good chance of being there.

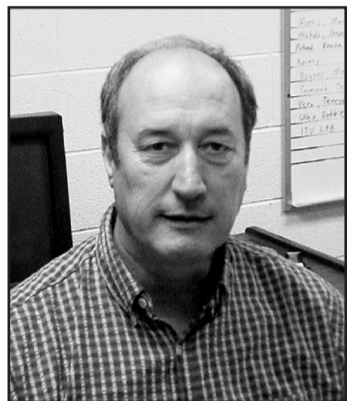
## I can't take it anymore

to the highway program developed under the Eisenhower years) where ocean water can be channeled throughout the U.S., whether it's North Dakota, Texas or Utah.

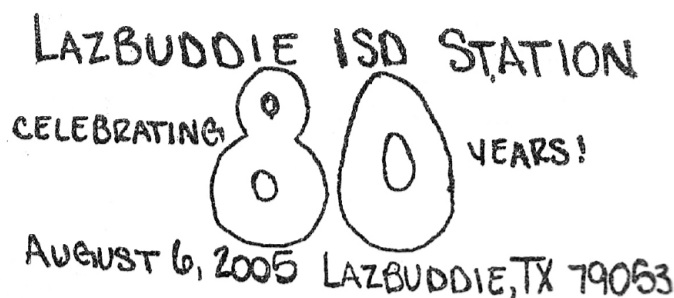
This is the type of project that should be our No. 1 federal priority.

Scattered showers have accompanied the cool front which moved into the area Thursday afternoon. Precipitation amounts have been reported from a trace to near one inch where rain was received.

Some area producers whose irrigation systems have not been able to keep up with crop demand are in desperate need of precipitation in order to maintain current yield potential. A good general rain would have a huge impact on many area crops. Most area corn is in the milk stage and is requiring about .30 inches of moisture per day. Daily moisture requirements will decrease fairly rapidly over the next three weeks.

## County's tax abatement policy may be dropped

The Parmer County Commissioners on Monday reviewed its tax abatement criteria for businesses seeking to move to Parmer County.

Since the policy began about six years ago, about 2 abatements have been granted.

County Judge Bonnie Heald said there's sentiment among the commissioners that no tax abatement policy is needed; that if a business wants to come here, they will, regardless of whether a tax abatement is offered.

No decision was made, but there's a good chance the policy, which is reviewed every two years, may be dropped.

In other business, the commissioners:

-- Scheduled a special meeting for 11 a.m. on Aug. 15 for county employees to discuss a cost of living program option offered through the Texas county and district retirement system.

-- Discussed with Parmer County Appraiser Curby Brantley the county's appraised values and effective tax rate. This will be finalized later.

-- Okayed the annual \$10 road and bridge fee for each vehicle registered in Parmer County.

-- Received a letter from Farwell Mayor Jimmie Mace and the city council regarding a small strip of property near Avenue A and 1st Street that Jay Bowers has offered to buy.

The tax property is jointly owned by the city, hospital district, school and county. His bid has been turned down by the government entities as too low.

The letter from the City of Farwell said:

"This property has been off the tax roll at least 18 years, if not longer. The city has kept the property mowed and weeded during this time at an estimated cost of \$100 per year, for a total of \$1,800, which we feel should be equally shared by the four entities, since each entity has a 1/4 vote.

"The cost to totally clean up this property is estimated between \$5,000 and \$10,000. There is concrete to remove and possibly an underground tank that will need to be removed; again we feel that this cost should be shared equally by the four entities.

"The city's goal is to get this property cleaned up, sold, and back on the tax roll."

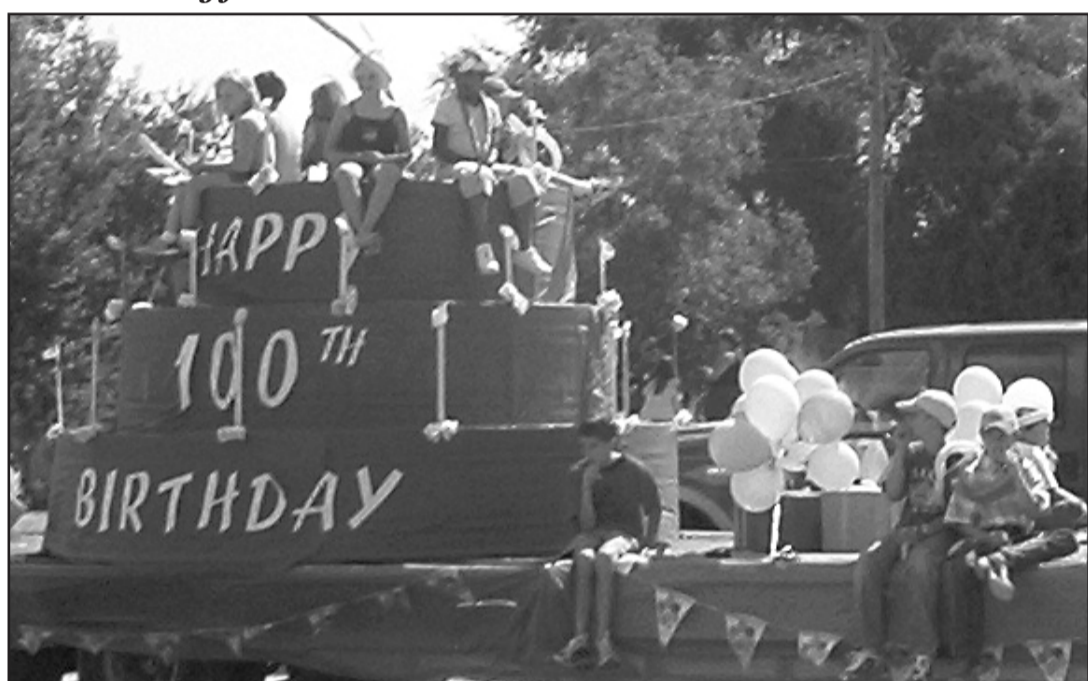

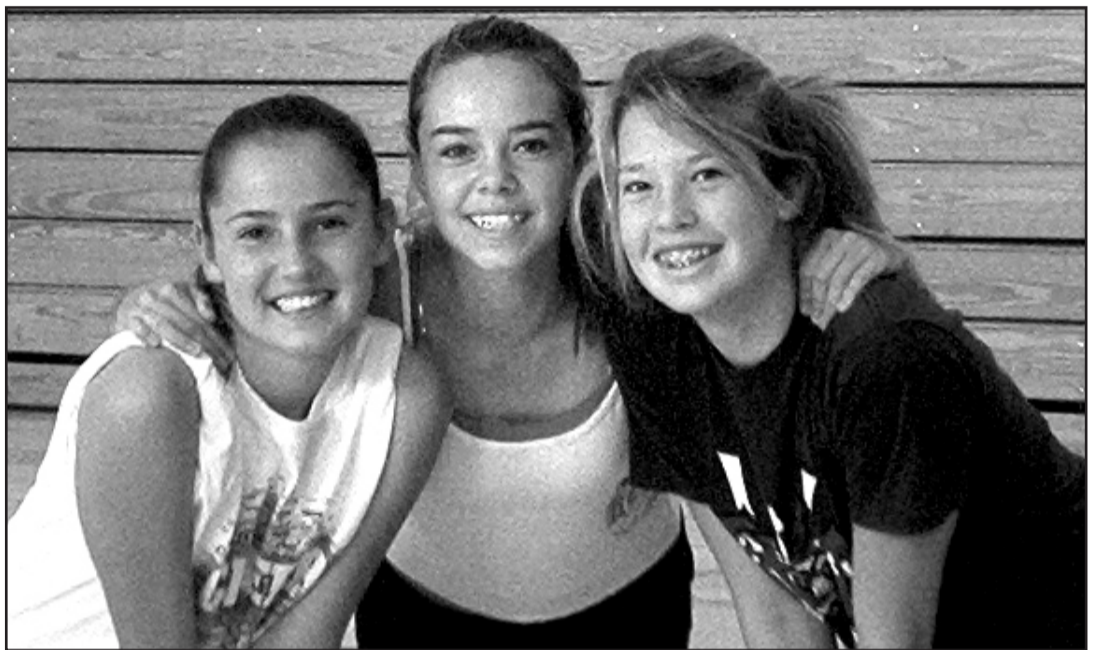

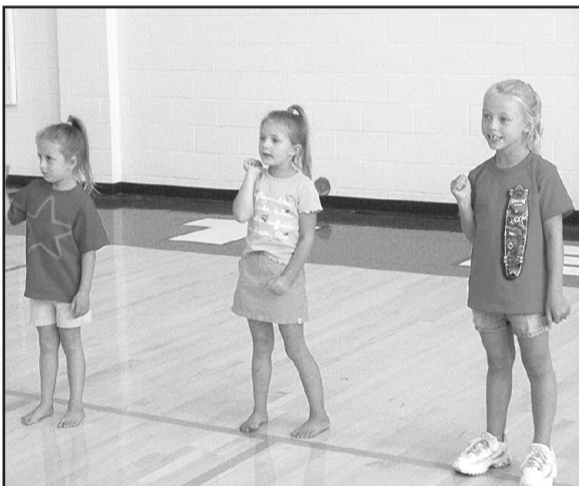

# Texico holds hearing on Ute Lake project

On Aug. 4, a hearing was held at the Texico Community Center concerning the Ute Water Project. Residents were asked to come and give their views.

The seven people who attended were Mayor Jerry Cunningham, Texico Fire Chief Lewis Cooper, Councilman Oran Jay Autrey, City Attorney Marion Rutter, City Clerk Mike Hannigan, and residents Ed Autrey and Ann Cooper.

Representing the Ute Water Project were Scott Verhines of GC Engineering, Inc. and Kevin Powers of RBC Dain Rauscher. They explained different alternatives for this project to lower cost and maintenance.

Due to Logan, San Jon, Quay County, and Tucumcari dropping out of the project, Texico's main concern is how this project is going to affect their residents' water bills.

The main idea of the Ute Lake project is to have treated water delivered to all these places as the primary supply of water. Existing wells would be the backup water supply.

The different alternatives all detailed the location of water treatment plants, pipelines, and other buildings needed for the project.

According to the original plan, the treatment plant was going to be located in Quay County. Since they have dropped out of the project, there is no reason that the plant be so far away for the areas that wish to use it. Verhines said a plant should be as close as possible to the areas of where it is pumped, in turn lowering cost.

The costs of this project (after construction) will be mainly energy, pumping, and treatment. This is a long process and it costs a lot of money to residents of these areas.

Another concern was farmers' and ranchers' lands. Some people are asking the Eastern New Mexico Water Authority for the pipelines be moved closer to their land so they may also have a supply. The different mapped alternatives would solve their problems.

All in all, for Texico, operating and maintenance costs are the biggest deal. The project authorities have no numbers to tell them what their water costs would be now that several areas have dropped out. Federal sharing, efficiency to lower costs, and the layout of the project are being discussed as of now and they are the biggest concerns for all people of the area.

An Aug. 17 workshop will be when they will decide or narrow down the alternatives to a few, and get all the details -- like cost. Then in September it will be presented and perhaps finalized.

# Dr. Sheets to continue operating Farwell clinic

Dr. Kyle Sheets has resigned from the Muleshoe Area Hospital District, effective in 90 days.

But Jack Kirkland, president of the Farwell Hospital District, said Dr. Sheets will continue to operate the Farwell Medical Clinic under the auspices of the Muleshoe Area Hospital District.

The Farwell Hospital District and the Muleshoe Area Hospital District have held negotiations this year to ensure continued operation of the Farwell Medical Clinic.

The clinic has been operating at a financial loss, so the Farwell Hospital District had agreed to provide a subsidy for 90 days.

By then, it is hoped that Dr. Sheets will operate the clinic on his own, said Kirkland. Dr. Sheets also operates other clinics in Clovis.

Dr. Sheets, or other doctors, normally come to the clinic one day a week. But the clinic stays open fulltime, operated by Marc Osborn, a certified family nurse practitioner.

Dr. Sheets is expected to continue handling the patients at the Farwell Convalescent Center.

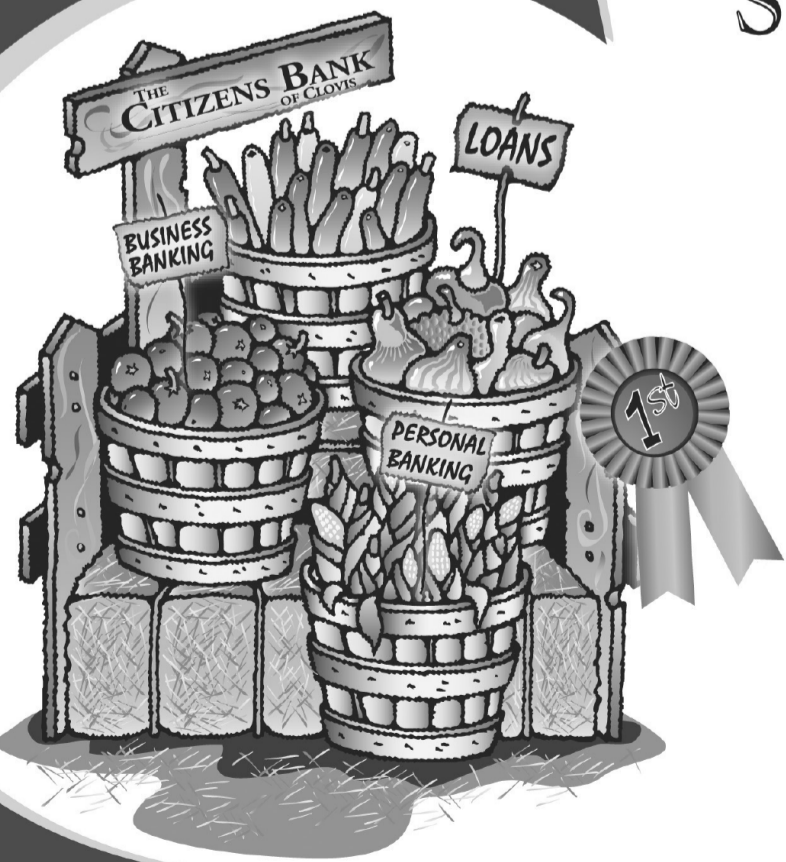

The Cervantezes are currently living with David and Deanna Curtis. That makes nine people living in that household and any help that you feel like giving would be very appreciated by all of those involved.

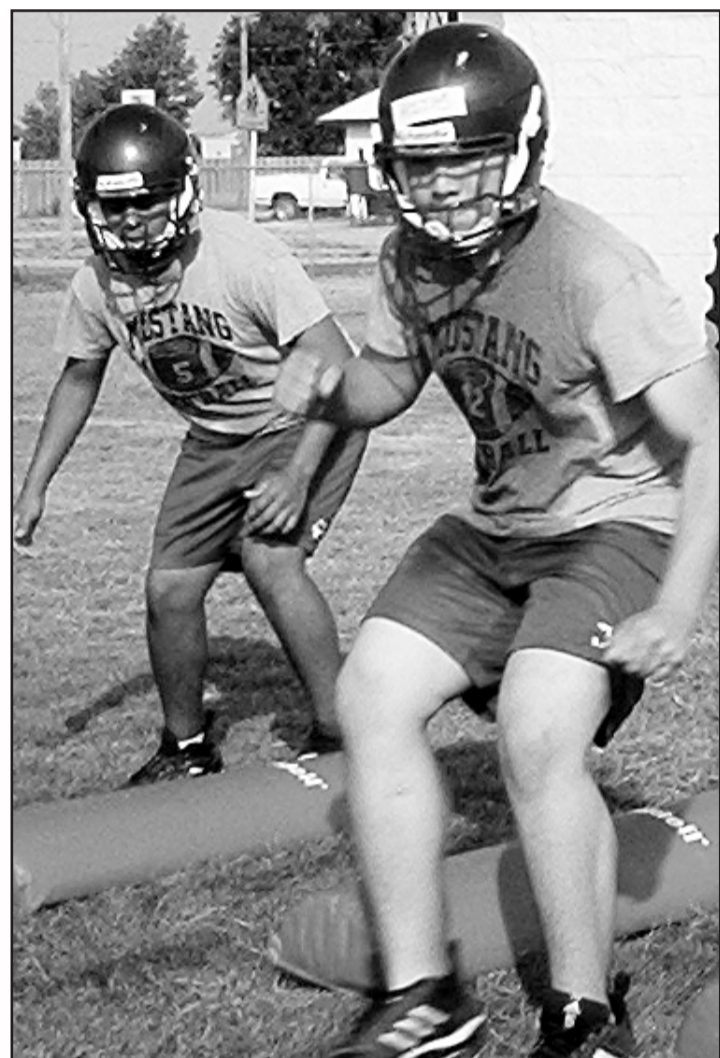
Diane has mentioned some things that are needed as of right now such as:

There will be more needs as time passes, but getting some of these supplies would greatly help out these two families. Of course, any food items and/or money would be appreciated.

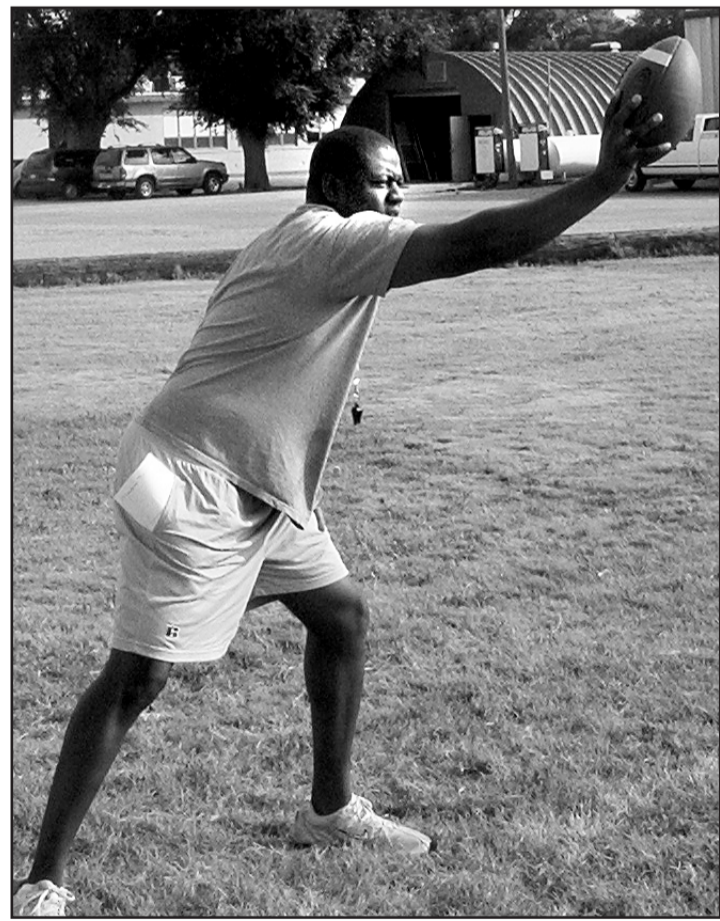

- Adopted the Student Code of Conduct.

**LIVE CATTLE:** It is normal during this time of the year to see a quick rally into early August and cash prices were up last week with most trades taking place around \$82.50. There are some strong seasonal tendencies for prices to drop into late August before turning back higher into October. Technically, the market has very little room to drop without making new lows? A drop below \$81 basis the October contract would only lead to lower cash into late August.

**FEEDER CATTLE:** Cash has helped to pull prices back higher. The spread between feeders and fed cattle prices are still historically wide, but has not deterred buyers from placing cattle on feed. Technically, a close below \$1.07 basis the October contract may lead to a sell-off into late August? This would be a normal seasonal tendency to trade lower over the next couple of weeks.

**CORN:** The market took another hit last week when extended weather forecasts called for cooler temps and normal moisture next week. The reality of the situation is that as of today, over 75% of the Corn Belt have received less than a quarter of an inch of rain over the last 10 days. Even if there are more losses in production, many analysts believe that with last year's carry out and this year's anticipated production, that prices may not see the \$2.60-2.70 levels for the rest of this year?

**SOYBEANS:** Beans also took a hit last week on forecasts of improving weather for next week. Weather in August will be the most important time frame affecting bean production. Higher soybeans would most likely be the key factor affecting corn prices over the next few weeks.

**WHEAT:** Prices fell along with the rest of the grain complex last week with little outside influence to give the market any direction of its own. The market will generally begin to move higher during the month of August and continue higher overall into the December/January time frame. For now, prices may continue to follow the rest of the grain complex until later in August.

**COTTON:** The market has been trapped inside a tight range over the last few weeks with overhead resistance around \$53.50 and support below at \$49.25 basis the December contract. Overall, the market has a tendency to move up a little into September before turning back down into the November/December time frame.



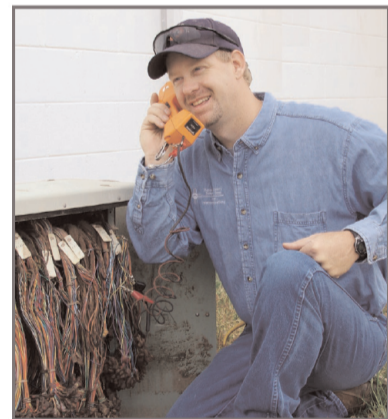

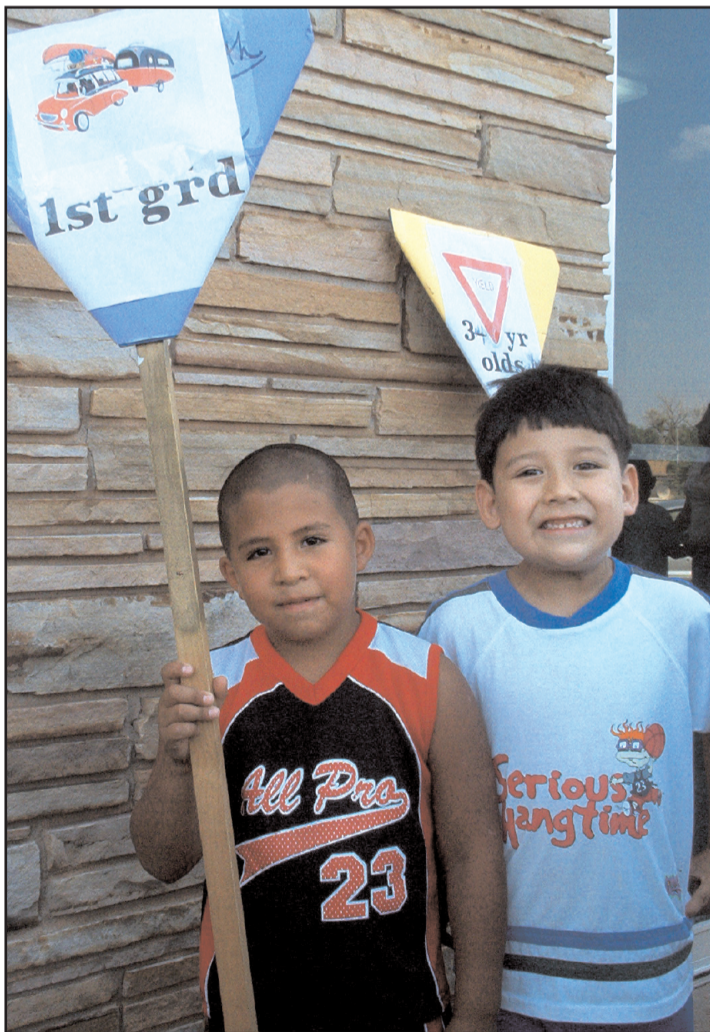
