

The \$2.6 million is divvied up

Parmer County law enforcement agencies have received quite a windfall:

First the background:

Last September, Texas State Trooper Isabel Carrasco made the largest cash seizure in the history of the Texas Panhandle (and the largest in the U.S. last year by an individual) --\$2,660,649.

He had stopped a truck just outside the Bovina city limits because the driver was not wearing a seat belt. After interviewing the driver and co-driver, he called for police backup. Then after getting permission to search the truck, he opened the back door and found eight cardboard boxes with the

Then-Parmer County Sheriff Gary Blair said the two men --Noe Ferreira and Rigoberto Soriano -- in the truck disclaimed any knowledge of the money and signed a waiver giving it



\$2.6 million -

That meant the money would be divvied up by governmental agencies, explained District Attorney Johnny Actkinson. Well, that has been accomplished.

On Feb. 6, a Judgment of Forfeiture was made in 287th District Court here. The court, after considering the evidence, decided that the "currency was contraband that was used or was intended to be used in the commission of a felony prohibited by the Texas Controlled Substance Act and should be forfeited to the State of Texas."

The funds were divvied up this way:

* Texas Department of Public Safety got 70 percent --\$1,862,314.30.

* Four police agencies -- Friona Police Department, Bovina Police Department, Farwell Police Department and Parmer County Sheriff's Office -- each got 2 percent -- \$53,212 apiece.

* The Parmer County Attorney's Office got 2 percent --

' The Parmer County District Attorney's Office got 20 percent -- \$532,129.80.

Signing the court agreement were Actkinson, County attorney Charles Aycock, Friona Police Chief Scott Given, Bovina Police Chief Leon Saddler, Farwell Police Chief Robert Achterberg and Capt. Russell Davis, of the Texas Department of Public Safety.

Actkinson further explained how this decision was reached in a letter to the Tribune:

"By way of background, there is a specific statute allowing for forfeiture of contraband which is used, or intended to be used, in the commission of a felony crime, or is the proceeds from the result of a felony crime. This means that any money, cars, houses, guns, knives or any other instrument which is used to help commit a crime can be forfeited. Our statutes provide that forfeiture of assets will result in money being paid to the state treasury unless there is a local agreement in regard to handling of the forfeiture. In Parmer County, each local agency has an agreement.

"The District Attorney's office is designated as the attorney to represent any and all law enforcement agencies in the county for forfeiture. As I mentioned, there are local agreements in place with each agency that the seizing agency will receive 70 percent of the total forfeited assets, and the District Attorney's Office will received 30 percent.

"We have actively sought forfeitures in all drug cases, This is generally limited to the car which the criminal is driving at the time he commits the crime. It could also result in the forfeiture of a house. In Parmer County and Bailey County, there have been forfeited two different houses and, probably, 10 to 15 cars in the last two years. We aggressively follow the forfeiture policy, as I believe this is a deterrent to criminal activity and it is also a source of extra funds for law enforcement.

"The statute on use of forfeited property provides that the forfeited money must be used solely for law enforcement purposes, such as salaries, overtime pay for officers, officer training, specialized investigative equipment, supplies, etc.

"Our Parmer County Commissioners Court and the City Councils of Friona, Bovina and Farwell are very responsive to the needs of law enforcement. Each one does a very good job of funding their law enforcement agency. However, there is always a good cause which can be funded with the forfeited

"With the recent forfeiture of \$2,660,649, there will be a significant addition of funds available to each agency of law enforcement in this country. We have decided to divide the funds between all the agencies as shown in the court judgment."

Actkinson said he plans to use the funds his office will receive to hire an assistant district attorney, who also will serve in an investigative capacity. There has been no investigator in

again win the World Series. The Atlanta Braves likely will be the also-ran.







Three coins were placed in a bag and marked 1, 2 and 3. Whoever drew the "3" got the bye -- which is what Scisson ton Center, 59-48, reported







* Upon enrollment or pre-enrollment for the fall semester, recipients must send the Cooperative a confirmation from the registrar's office. Should a recipient drop out of school for any reason, the unused portion of the scholarship will be rescinded.

At the end of each semester, recipients must send a report of their grades to: Rick Bartels, West Texas Rural Telephone Cooperative, Box 1737, Hereford, Texas 79045. Failure to do so will result in ineligibility for further payments.

Texico annexes Avenue F areas into city

The Texico City Council Tuesday discussed the proposed 20-unit, low income apartment development planned for the Burrows property at the south side of town.

The council thought that a zoning change would have to be approved before the development could proceed, but it was found that an ordinance was already in place to cover the development.

No zone change from single family dwellings to multifamily dwellings will be needed by this ordinance.

The ordinance has been in place since Aug. 21, 1964. The lifting of the covenants is now the only issue to be dealt with by the landowners, Jim and Carolyn Burrows. They have put in a request for this and are having them researched.

The Community Unity Plan, as outlined in the ordinance allows for anyone that owns a parcel of land of 10 acres or more to present a plan for development to the city council.

Several residents attended the meeting to voice opposition and concerns to the development. However, no questions could be answered by the council directly.

Representatives from the Eastern Plains Council of Governments will be attend the Feb. 27 meeting to handle all inquiries and opposition. The builder, Johnathan Reed, will also attend.

The primary opposition that has been voiced is the loss of property values to adjacent, single family homes and acreages.

In other business, the 4.56 acres that is directly south of Ave. F was approved for annexation into the city and there was some discussion on the building plans for a new city hall. No further action was taken on this matter, pending costs being gathered from architecture firms.

Rutter's only concern was wanting to make sure that if Texico made agreements to purchase water from the Texas organization (the Llano Estacado Water Plan) and by staying in the Ute Lake Project that they could still exercise their options for water.

The Texas organization is the one that Farwell is part of. Texico wants to have the option to buy water from this organization if needed without having to withdraw from the Ute Lake Project.

Mayor Marie Christian brought up the question of the health and welfare of the community due to the planned dairy. She had researched whether there was an ordinance dealing with the slurry that the dairy would produce.

There are no such ordinances in place for slurry, only animal waste. To handle this, Rutter will prepare a public nuisance ordinance outline that will be discussed and modified at the next council meeting.

The Curry County Builders/Contractors Association has offered to donate the materials for the construction of a permanent banner structure

to hang banners over the highway. The BCA only wants Texico to take on the liability insurance for this. There was discussion over whether the city's insurance premiums would go up and by how much.

It was decided to ask the insurance company these questions and to make the request based on the poles for the structure being moved further back from the sides of the road to the same distance as the utility poles. council felt this might make a difference in the cost of insuring them. This will be discussed at the next meeting.

The bid from Carolyn Johnson was approved for cleaning the Texico City Hall and Community Center.

Glen Robertson of Fossil Creek Land Co. discussed the opportunity of his company to erect a cellular tower within the city limits. Alamosa PCS, a subsidiary of Sprint PCS would like to erect a 199-ft. tower to enhance cellular/digital communications in the area. It will also provide another option for cellular service.

Alamosa PCS has con-

tracted Fossil Creek Land Co. to acquire the land needed to erect the tower. Further information and all permits will be discussed and reviewed at the next council meeting.

Texico Fire Chief Lewis Cooper made presentations for several items needed by the Fire Dept. and EMS.

A new generator is needed and he has located two at the Federal Surplus in Sante Fe. Jeff Queener will accompany Cooper to look at these generators. They will also look for a siren to put up on the west side of town. Curry County has offered a siren that needs repair to the city, but Cooper wants to see what Federal Surplus has available as well.

Cooper also presented a request for a new repeater for Texico. He said communications for emergency personnel are very poor with the It was present system. agreed that there is a need for a new system, but the funding for it is the main problem.

Financial Focus by Glen O'Rear

If you've ever thought about retiring early, then you know there's one major concern you'll need to address: money. Will you have enough? And where will it come from?

Barring a disability, you can't start collecting Social Security until you're 62. When you retire early, it would be extremely helpful if you had a source of income to tide you over until you reach that age. But if you tap into your IRA or 401(k) before you're 59 1/2, won't you have to pay a 10 percent penalty on the distributions you take out?

Not necessarily. According to Section 72(t) of the Internal Revenue Code, you may be able to tap into your IRA or 401(k) before age 59-1/2 and still avoid the penalty. How? By taking the funds in a series of "substantially equal periodic payments."

This somewhat "jargony" phrase simply means you've got to withdraw about the same amount of money at least once a year. You have to make these withdrawals for at least five years, or until you've reached age 59-1/2, whichever is longer. So, for example, if you start taking these payments at age 50, you'll need to continue them until you're 59-1/2. If you don't start taking the payments until you're 57, you have to keep going until you're

How much can you withdraw? Unfortunately, you can't just choose the amount you think you'll need. Typically, IRS regulations require that the size of the payments be based on your life expectancy -- or on the joint life expectancy of you and your beneficiary -- and a given interest rate.

Clearly, it's a good thing to avoid the 10 percent penalty, which could amount to thousands of dollars over time. Nonetheless, just because you can access your IRA or 401(k) without paying a penalty doesn't mean you should. Why? For one thing, even though your withdrawals may not incur any penalties, they will trigger income taxes. This could be especially costly if your tax bracket doesn't drop in retirement.

Even more importantly, your IRA or 401(k) provides tax deferred growth for your retirement savings. The longer you leave these funds alone, the greater your accumulation will be. That added growth will be very helpful later on in your retirement, when you really do need the money.

One more point to consider: When you have a 401(k), you still have to separate from employment before you can take money out, even using the Section 72(t) provision. With an IRA, you can start making 72(t) withdrawals at any time.

In any case, weigh your decision carefully. You worked long and hard to build up your IRA or 401(k). Don't be in a hurry to dismantle them.
