Wheeler County Tax Collector, Lewis Scott Porter Files For Re-election

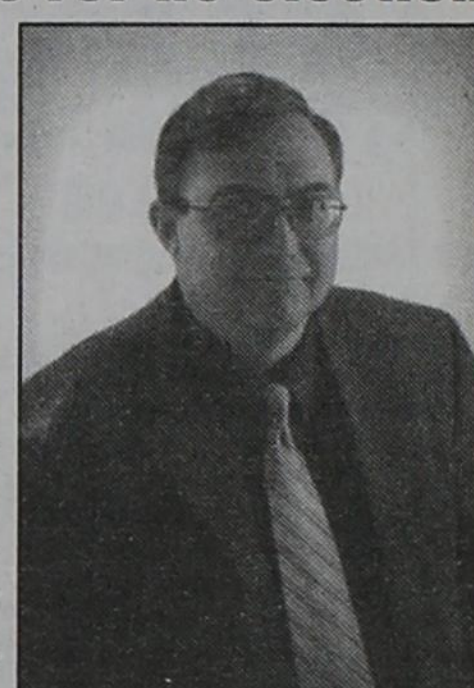
I am announcing my intentions to run for re-election for Wheeler County Tax Assessor/Collector.

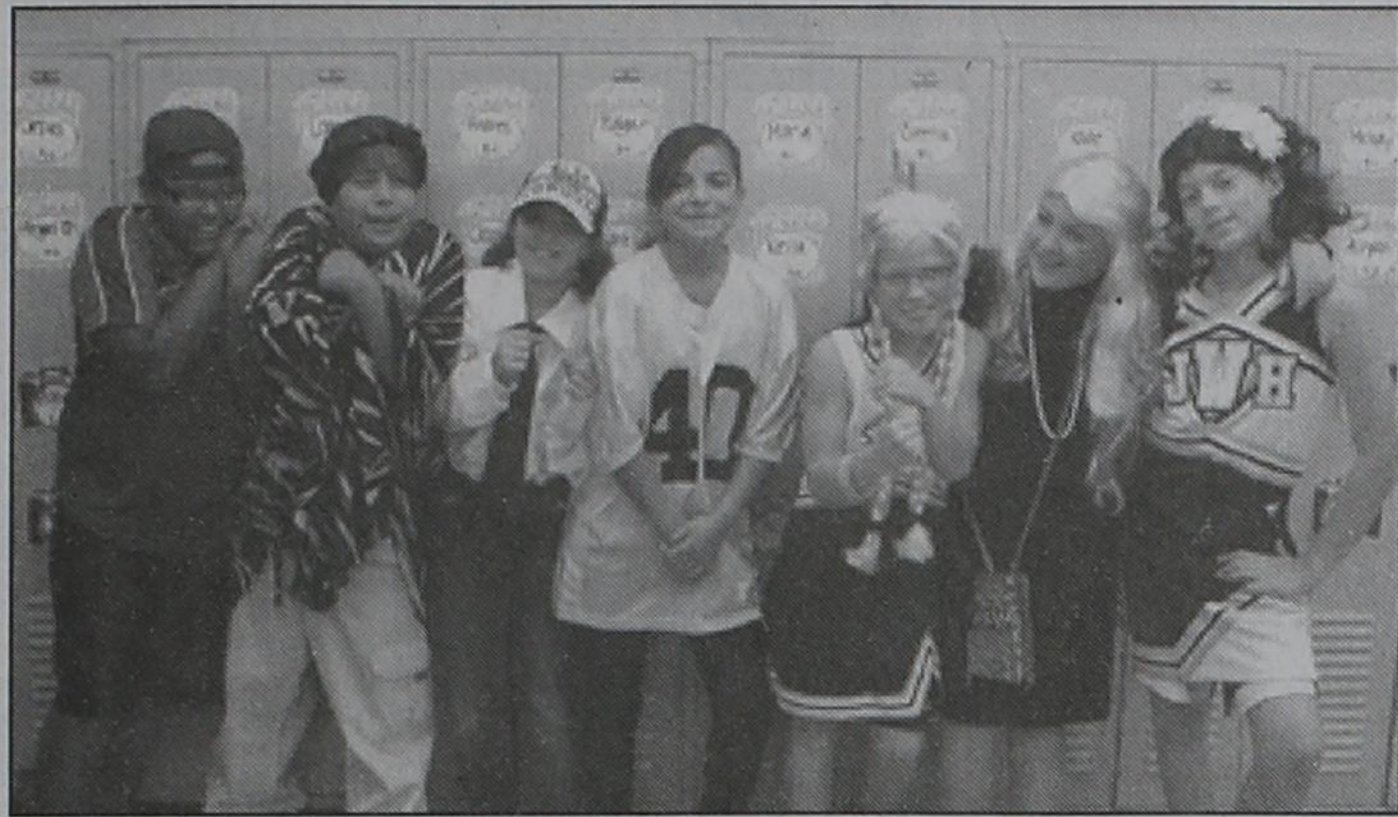

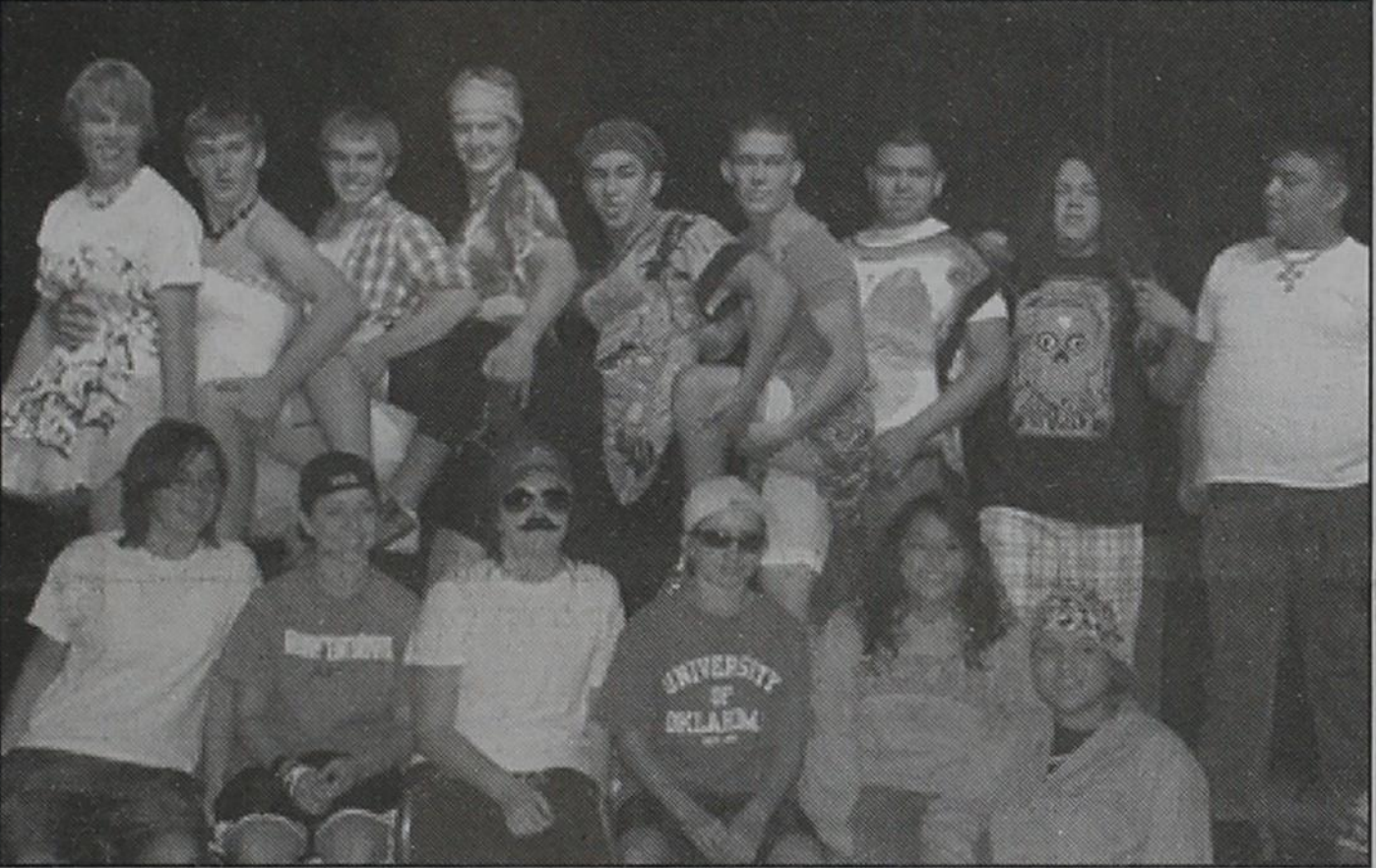

next regular meeting of the Commissioners' Court will be Friday, October 7 at 10:00 a.m.

The court voted to give Wheeler and Shamrock Meals on Wheels a grant of \$500 each.

Margaret Dorman, County Clerk, request permission of the court to combine the voting precincts for the upcoming constitutional amendment election November 8, 2011; this was approved by the court. The location of the two polling places for the election have not been announced; one will be in Wheeler and one will be in Shamrock. Absentee voting will begin October 24 and continue through Nov. 4. Absentee voting for precincts 1 & 2 vote is at the County Clerk's office and precincts 3 & 4 will vote at the City Hall in Shamrock. Anyone over 65 can request a ballot be mailed to them.

The court voted to accept TAC HEBP's renewal (County Health Insurance).

The court also voted to renew the county's TCDRS Retirement Plan for 2012.

Rowdy Clark, Wheeler County Deputy, met with the court to inform the court of the cost of the two new units to be purchased by the Sheriff's Department. The cost will be \$37,000 each; the units will be fully equipped except for the radar. No action was taken.

Joel Finsterwald, Wheeler County Sheriff, met with the court to inform them of the problem with the jail; the plumbing on the second floor is leaking. The jail only has 9 beds, due to the problem. No action was taken.

Mark Brown, Wheeler County Justice of the Peace, Pct. 1, requested the county install a 4'x4' security entrance into his office at the old jail on the southeast corner of the courthouse square. The court approved the spending of \$17,000 for this project, which includes two steel doors, bullet proof glass in front of the clerk's desk and a remote lock for the door into the office.

The court approved the boring of County Roads, 15, H, J, 20, 22, and 29 by Oneok NGL Pipeline, LLC for the laying of an underground Utility and Pipeline.

The court approved the boring of County Roads, P, N, O, 20, 21, 17, K, 22, and 25 by Eagle Rock Energy Partners, LP for the laying of an underground Utility and Pipeline.

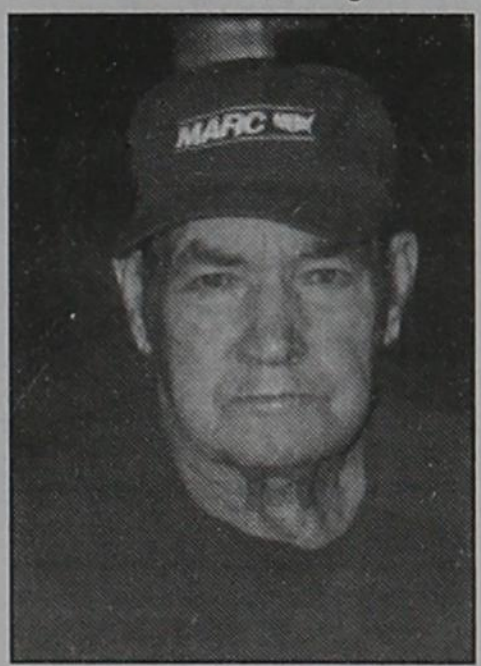

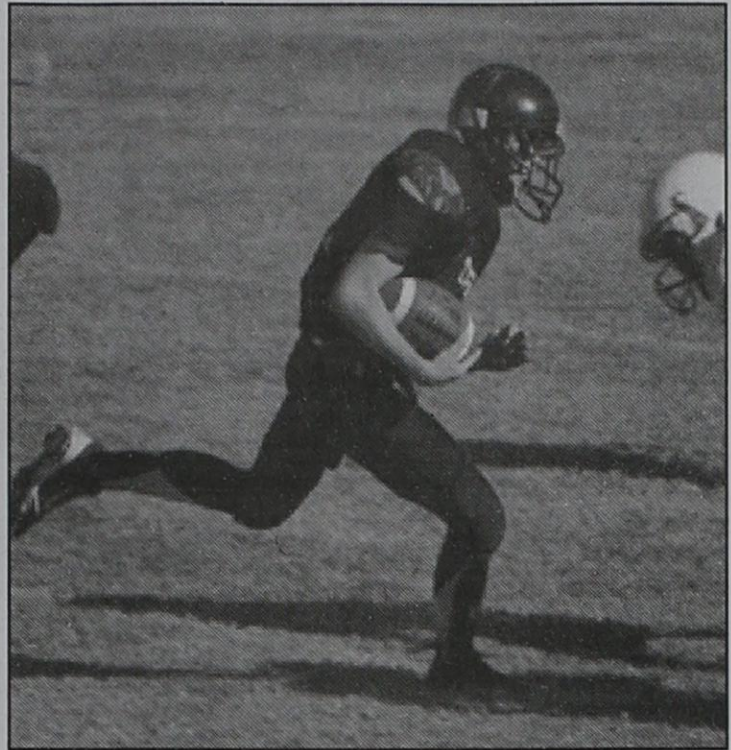
