





Barely Missed That Coyote!

A couple of weeks ago, I wrote got our rifle. Just as I got back out a little story about killing a rattlesnake and my father-in-law's cotton trailer tire, with just one shotgun blast. I also, mentioned how much he enjoyed telling that story. About three, or four years after that incident, we decided to go in together and order an old WWI army rifle that we'd seen advertised in a gun magazine. These surplus rifles were called, the Model 1903 Springfield. They were 30-06 caliber, and compatible with civilian hunting ammo. Not only that, but they were "dirt cheap." I believe we gave ten dollars for the rifle and four dollars for shipping. We ordered it in early December of 1967 and received it about the middle of February 1968. The barrel and every other available space was full of "cosmoline," a really thick grease that kept it from rusting, while being stored in a warehouse for about twenty five or thirty years. I spent at least six hours in an old, unheated garage, trying to get all that stuff out and shot it a couple of times each. It "kicked like a blue mule," but we were sur proud of it. We finally had a high-powered, "coyote killer." I took it to a gunsmith in Amarillo, and had a sixpower scope mounted on it. After that, we took it out and sighted it in. Now, look out coyotes! We always kept the rifle down here at his house, because I didn't have any use for it at Amarillo. A few months later, we were here for a visit and I was curious to know if he'd shot at any coyotes with it, so I asked him. He laughed and told me, "As a matter of fact, I shot at one just last week. I stepped out the back door and there was a coyote sitting in the hog pasture, staring at one of my young pigs.
