Russell Stephen Atherton stepped away from the arms of his loving family and into the arms of his Savior, on Thursday November 29, 2012 at his rig north of Huntsville, TX.

Services will be held December 6, 2012 in the new Cornerstone Church with his beloved Pastor, Erron Mercer, officiating. Burial will be in the Wheeler Cemetery under the direction of Thomas Peppers, Peppers Family Funeral Home.

Rusty was born January 23, 1951 in Wheeler, TX to Darville E. and Sammie (Dougherty) Atherton. Rusty attended all 12 school years in Briscoe TX and graduated as Salutatorian of his class in 1969. He was listed in Who's Who of American High School Students. He was a talented player on the Briscoe Bronco's basketball team.

Following in his Dad's steps, Rusty enlisted in the United States Marine Corps. His job was in Communications and Electronics and he excelled in all aspects of training, both educational and physical, achieving the rank of Sgt. He was proud of his service to his country as a Marine, and held in his heart "Once a Marine always a Marine." He was a true patriot, a man who loved his country regardless of whether he was in agreement with the politics of government. He was proud to be an American and a Texan. He was a man of strong convictions and was proud to stand strong for what he believed in and to speak out against what he felt was wrong.

He returned home after his hitch in the Marines and settled down to continue the family farming and ranching operation. He felt he could better provide for his family by working in the oilfield, and thus began his lifelong career. He began by working intermittently for a few months, until he began working for Parker Drilling where he found a "home". From worm corner he proved his mettle and climbed through the positions up to driller, junior tool pusher and finally senior pusher. He worked for Parker from early 1975 until Unit Drilling bought Parker, then he continued to work for Unit. He was assigned to Unit Rig 237 and it became his home-away-from-home for many years, as most of its wells were drilled south of the Panhandle toward the Houston area. Over the course of his career he made many friends and earned the respect of men whom he respected. He also gained a second family of roughnecks, company men, and others within

the profession. It was his good fortune that he was doing what he loved when God called his name, and even more so that he was surrounded by his hands, men who loved and respected him beyond measure and who were dedicated to living up to the work ethic Rusty proved by his own example.

Rusty is survived by his wife Noveta Francis Aderholt Atherton of the home; two daughters and spouses Angel Atherton Thomas and John Rosson, and Chynna Atherton Lopez and Nino Lopez, all of Wheeler; three step-children (whose Dad was Mike Aderholt, deceased) DeAnn Aderholt of Yukon, OK, Kelly Aderholt of Wheeler, and Misty Snelgrooves and Will Snelgrooves of Wheeler. Others include his church family and a multitude of friends; and last but certainly not least, the men who have worked on his rig and who made his work so worthwhile to him. 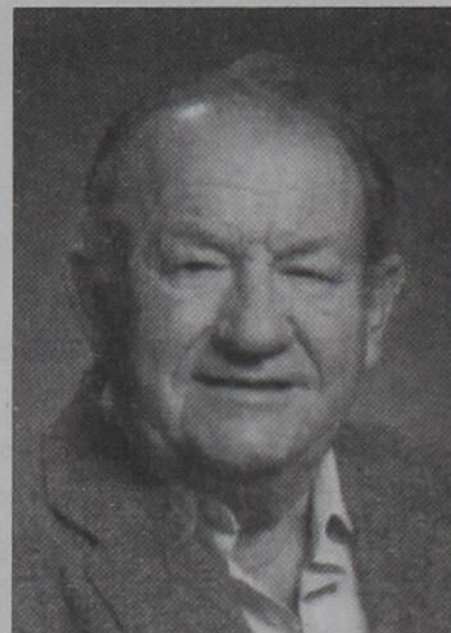

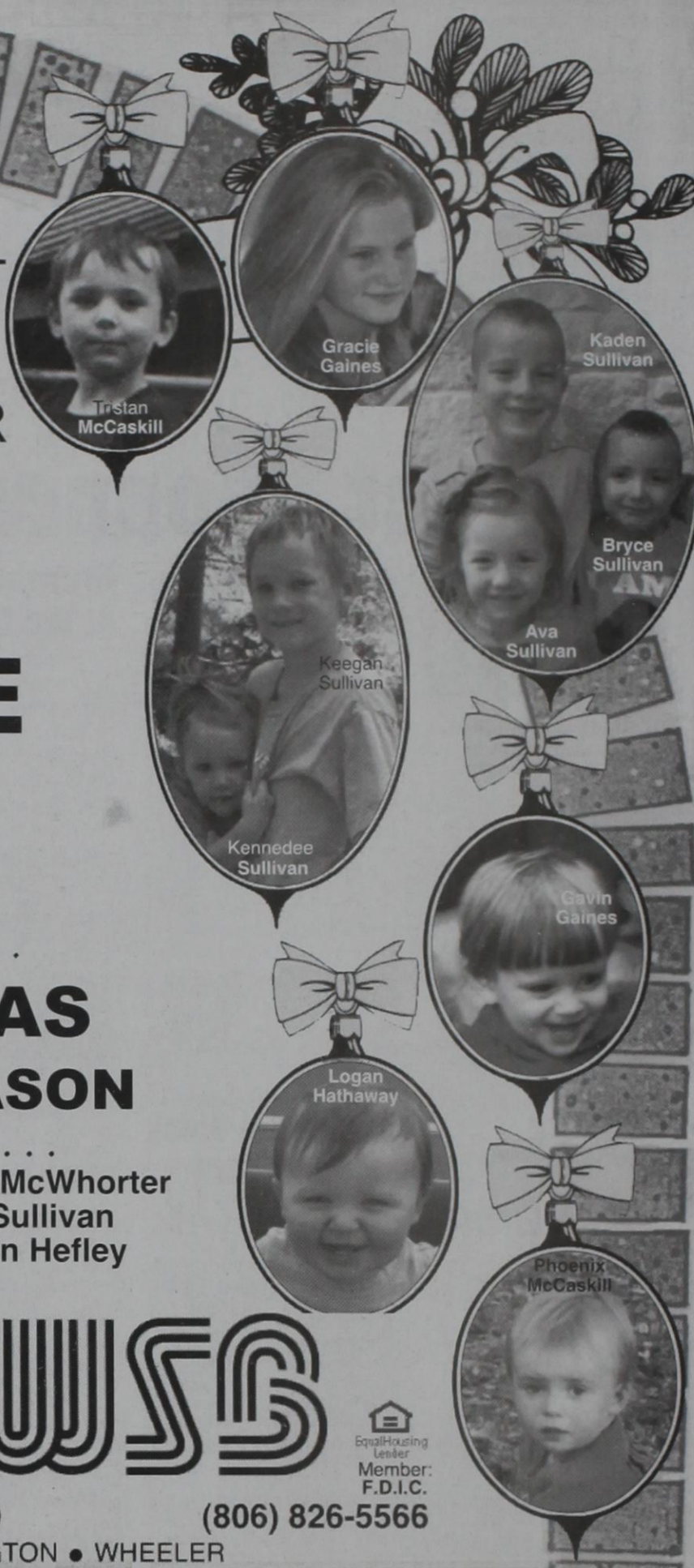

Wheeler Girls Lose Two Games Nov. 26

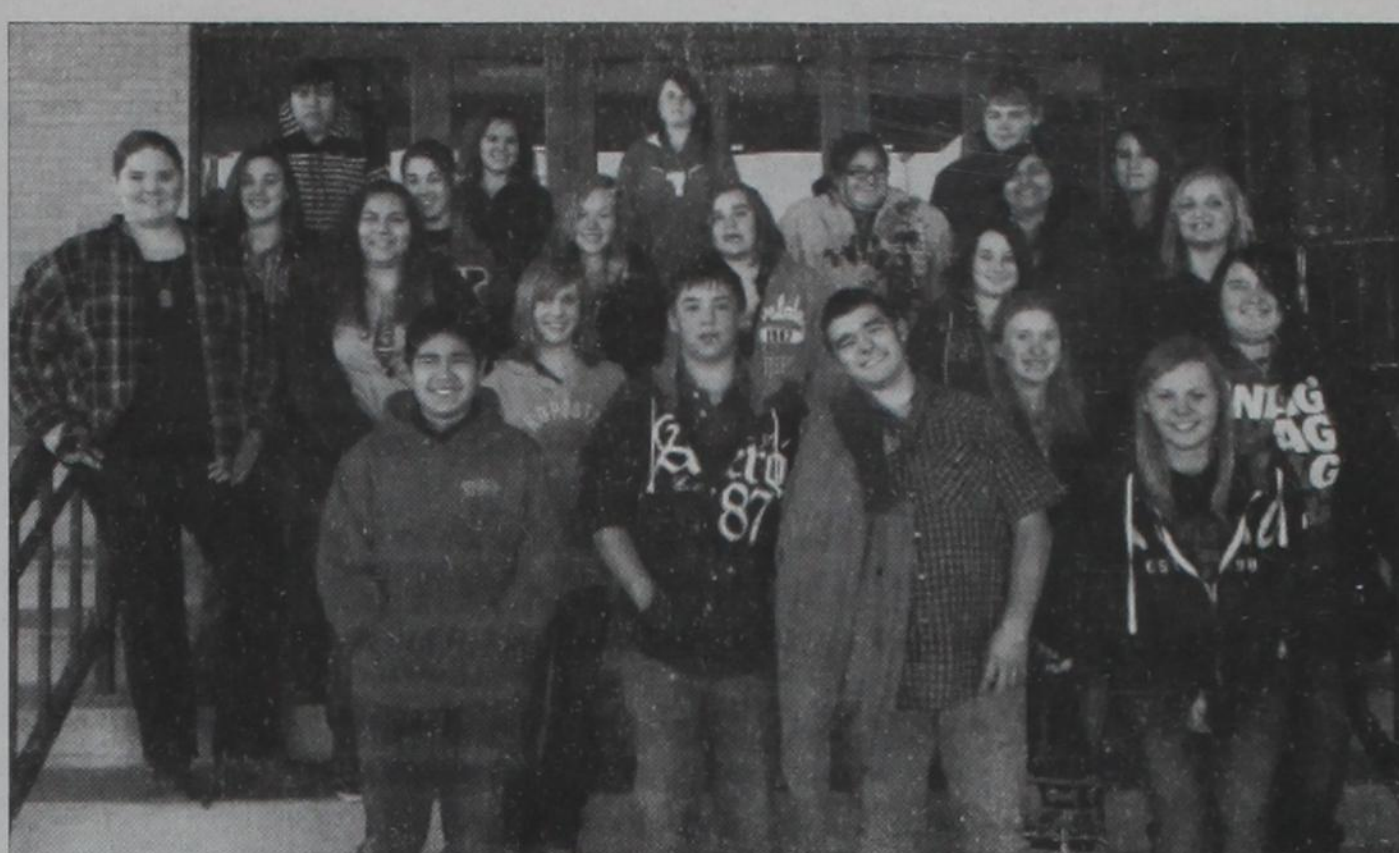
Wheeler's Lady Mustangs met Erick on the court on Monday, November 26. Erick won the game 54-28.

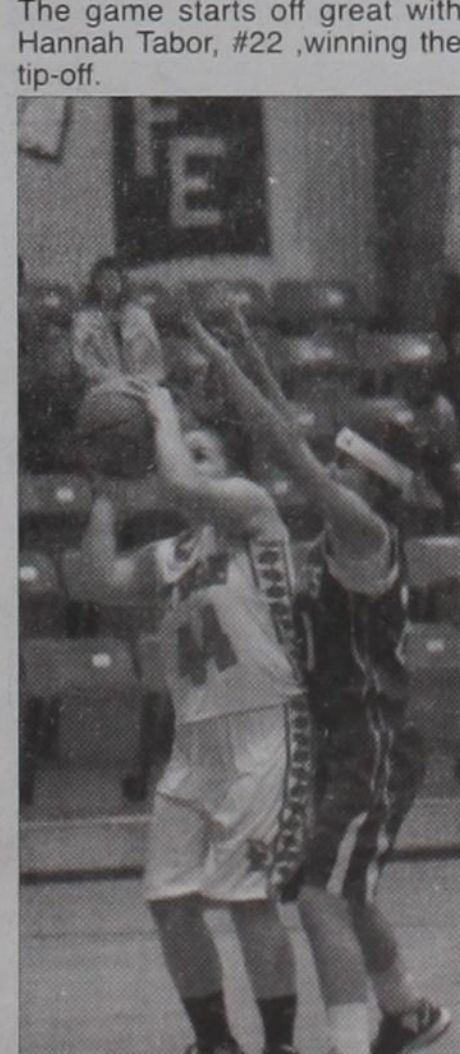

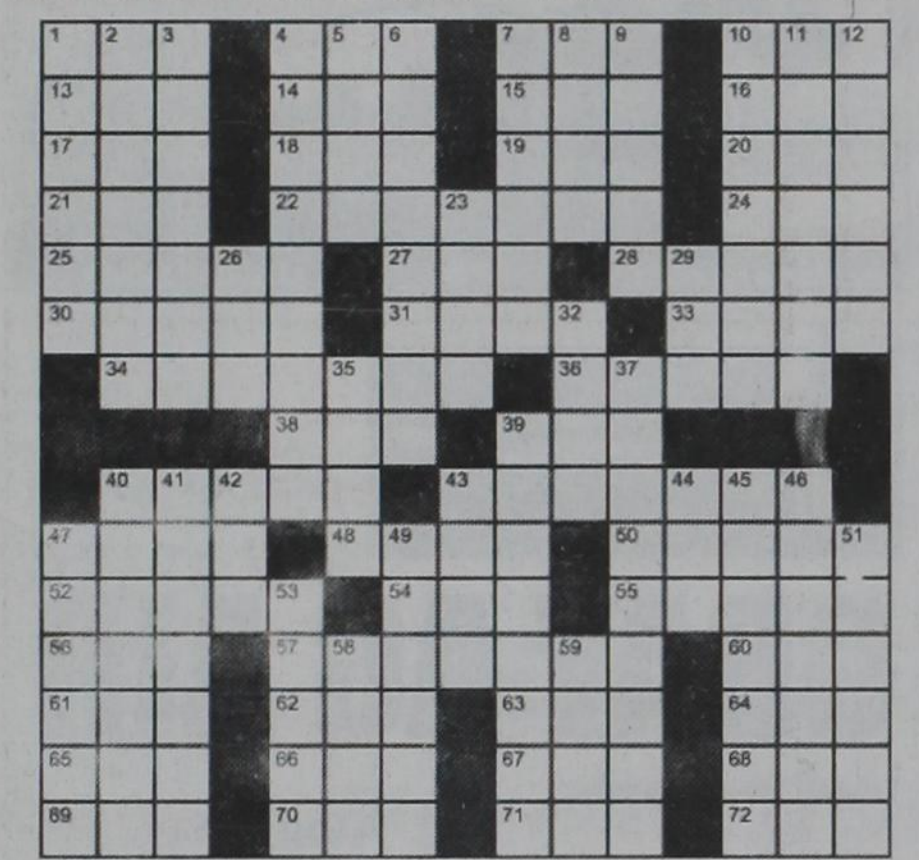

OLD TIMES NOT FORGOTTEN

Barely Missed That Coyote!

A couple of weeks ago, I wrote a little story about killing a rattlesnake and my father-in-law's cotton trailer tire, with just one shotgun blast. I also, mentioned how much he enjoyed telling that story. About three, or four years after that incident, we decided to go in together and order an old WWI army rifle that we'd seen advertised in a gun magazine. These surplus rifles were called, the Model 1903 Springfield. They were 30-06 caliber, and compatible with civilian hunting ammo. Not only that, but they were "dirt cheap." I believe we gave ten dollars for the rifle and four dollars for shipping. We ordered it in early December of 1967 and received it about the middle of February 1968. The barrel and every other available space was full of "cosmoline," a really thick grease that kept it from rusting, while being stored in a warehouse for about twenty five or thirty years. I spent at least six hours in an old, unheated garage, trying to get all that stuff out and shot it a couple of times each. It "kicked like a blue mule," but we were sur proud of it. We finally had a high-powered, "coyote killer." I took it to a gunsmith in Amarillo, and had a six-power scope mounted on it. After that, we took it out and sighted it in. Now, look out coyotes! We always kept the rifle down here at his house, because I didn't have any use for it at Amarillo. A few months later, we were here for a visit and I was curious to know if he'd shot at any coyotes with it, so I asked him. He laughed and told me, "As a matter of fact, I shot at one just last week. I stepped out the back door and there was a coyote sitting in the hog pasture, staring at one of my young pigs. So, I ran back in the house and

got our rifle. Just as I got back out side, the coyote took right in after that pig. I leveled down on him, took dead aim and squeezed the trigger. I blew that pig all to pieces! The coyote just wrung its tail and disappeared over the hill." He thought it was about as funny as I did. I'll bet that pig was worth more than the cotton trailer tire that I shot.

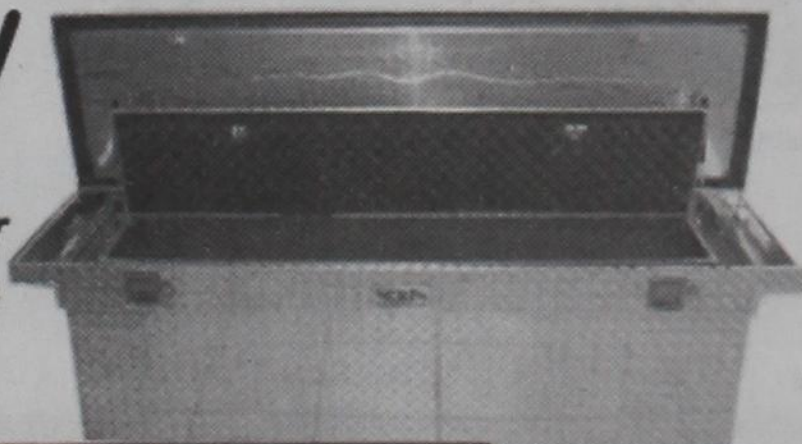

One never knows what is go-

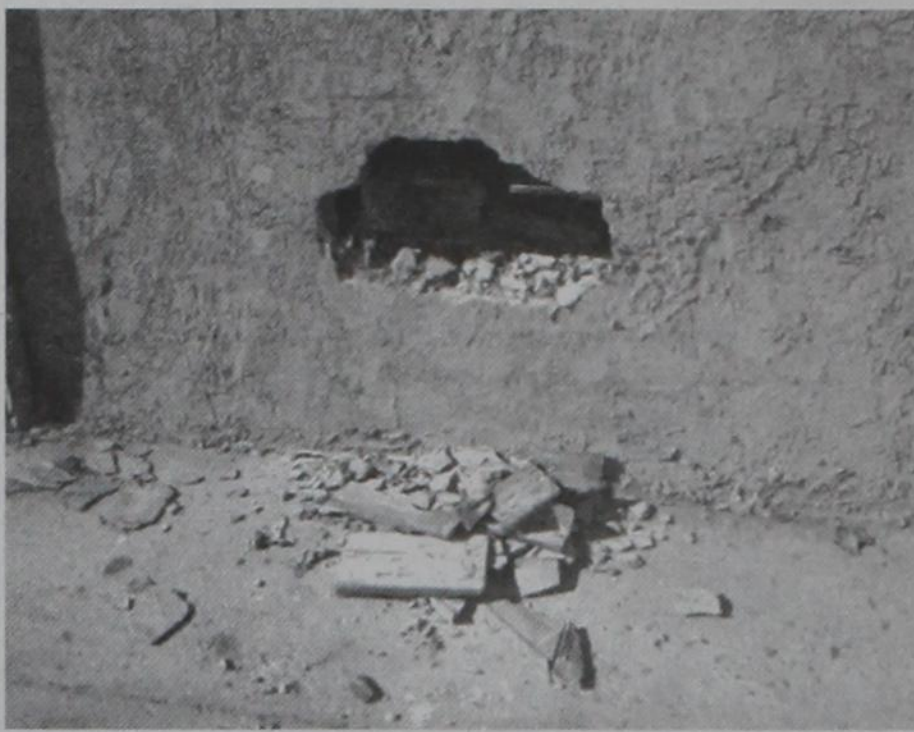
