Have you heard about the young man who was applying for life insurance? In the investigation that preceded the acceptance of his application, he was asked about any diseases that had existed in his family in the past and then he was specifically asked what had caused the death of one of his grandparents. Wanting to leave the best possible impression, he replied: "I don't really remember, but I don't think that it was anything serious."

For some reason, most people are paranoid about serious disease. It would seem that most people are less concerned about death than they are the diseases which cause death.

will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory. O Death, where is your victory? O Death, where is your sting? The sting of death of sin is the law; but thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." (I Corinthians 15: 54-57)

Such an attitude hardly seems logical. Consider these Biblical observations.

1. Death is certain. Hebrews 9:27 says: "It is appointed for men to die once--." No one gets out of this world alive! There are none on whom death will not call. Death is life's greatest, perhaps its only, certainty.

2. For Christians, death is not the end of life. But it is the beginning of life, a life that is to be lived in the presence of God. And in this life-- "there shall no longer be any death; there shall no longer be any mourning or crying, or pain--." (Revelation 21:4)

Perhaps these two observations are best summarized by the Apostle Paul when he wrote: "This perishable will have put on the imperishable, and this mortal

There is an old legend about a merchant in Bagdad who sent his servant to the market. Soon the servant was back, pale and trembling, and said: "Master, at the market, I was jostled by Death. And Death made a threatening gesture at me. Please lend me your horse that I may go to Samarra and hide. Death will never find me in Samarra."

The merchant lent the servant his horse and he hurried away to Samarra. Later the merchant went to the market and saw Death standing in the crowd. The merchant said: "Death, why did you make a threatening gesture at my servant?"

All of us have an appointment in Samarra. Death is certain. But it is not a cause of fear if we have obeyed him who said: "Because I live, you shall live also."
