



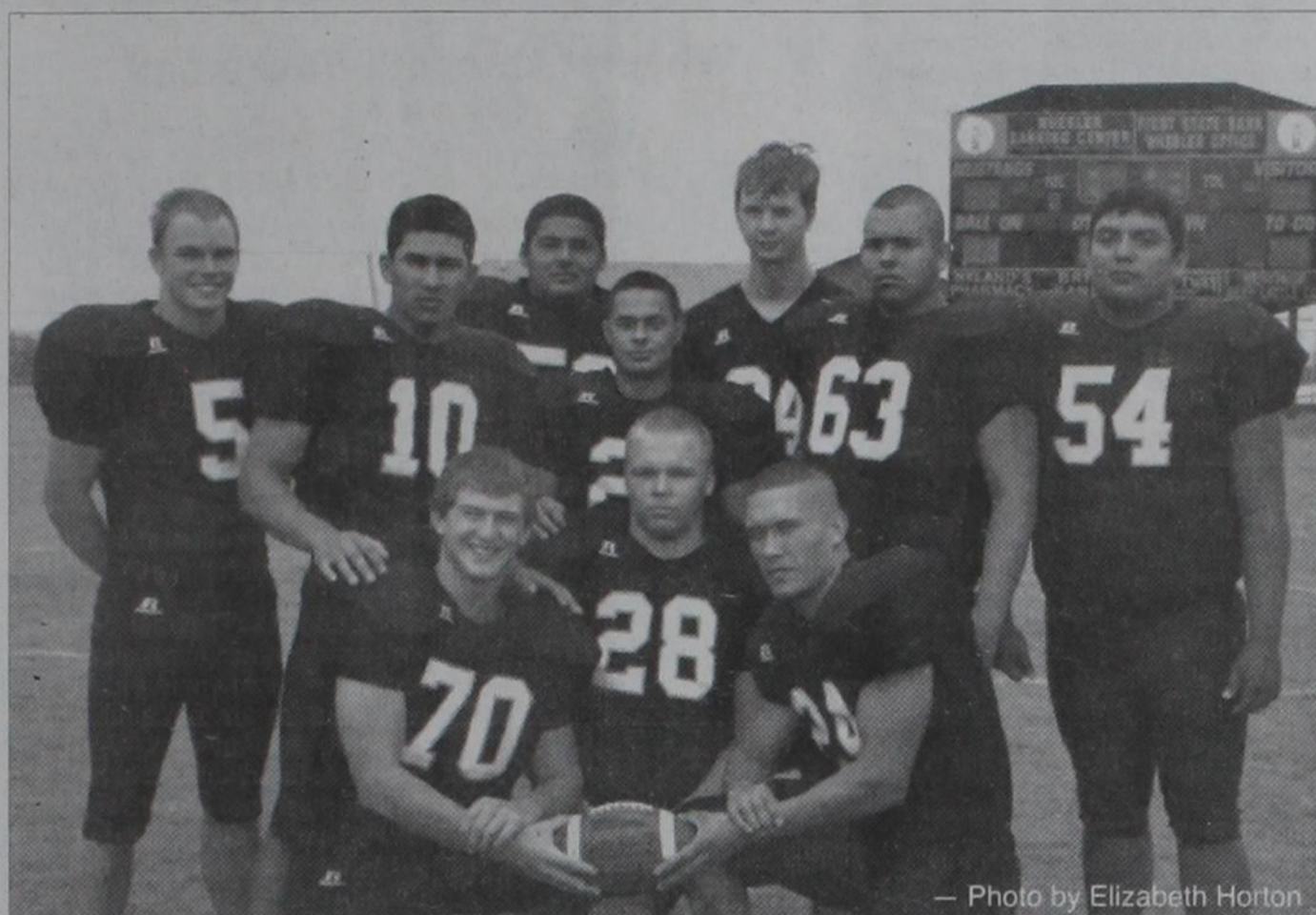

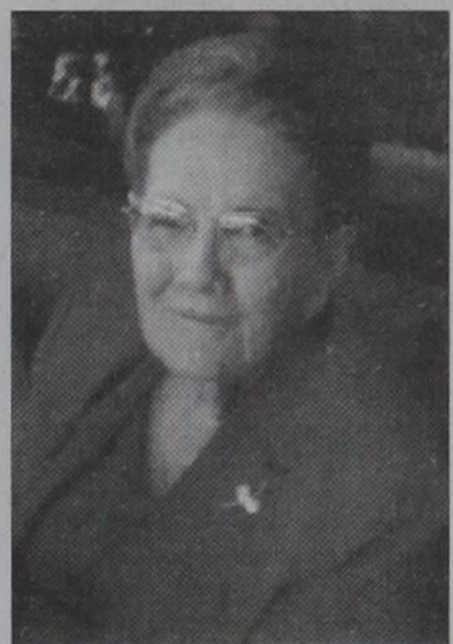

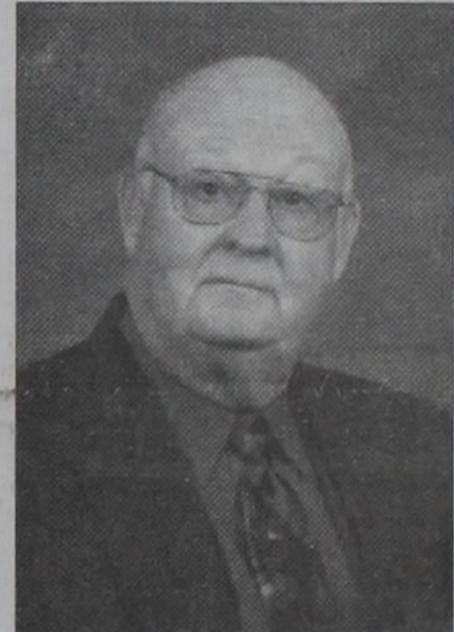

Mass for Mrs. Dorothy Amelia (Lohberger) Walker, 92, of Allison was held at 10:00 AM, Wednesday, October 31, 2012, at St Mary's Catholic Church, Wheeler, Texas, with Father Balla Showreddy officiating. Burial followed at Zybach Cemetery, Allison, Texas, under the direction of Peppers Family Funeral Home, Wheeler, Texas.

Dorothy Amelia Lohberger Walker, after living a full life, closed the gate for herself and her siblings October 28, 2012, just one day shy of her ninety-third birthday. Dorothy Walker was born October 29, 1919m, in Wheeler County, Texas, to William Edward Lohberger and Clara Phymenia (Bouquet) Lohberger. She was the youngest child on the Lohberger Home Place to pioneering parents, William and Clara Bouquet Lohberger. Delivered by Dr. Joss, Dorothy weighed less than three pounds. Tucked among towels in a boot box, she went nameless for several days because she wasn't expected to live, but her strong survival instincts persevered.

Dorothy started school in Zybach and continued there until its closing. Her graduation year 1936, from Briscoe, was memorable. She remembered working on her senior sewing project while her mother tended to the dying wife of outlaw, Jesse West. Her father treated her senior class to a trip to Carlsbad Caverns. Sadly her mother was to die in a car accident that same year.

On September 13, 1936, she married George Clifton Walker at the Canadian Catholic

Church. This marriage lasted sixty-nine years until Bulldog's passing in 2006. This union, three children were born.

After they moved to California, war was declared in 1941. Dorothy worked in an airplane battery factory. Her father's illness brought them back to Texas to work the farm.

Community service was an important part of Dorothy's life. Writing the town's history and involving herself in the Home Demonstration Club were just a few things she busied herself doing. She worked for the Briscoe Post Office in different capacities for over twenty years, retiring in 1980.

After retiring, she traveled with her husband in Europe and in all but two of the United States. Her family will remember her apricot cobbler, her doll collection, her roses and her written family (Continued Page 10)

and a three month old sister, Haley. Bradley was diagnosed with acute lymphoblast leukemia on September 26, 2012. Since then, he has had three blood transfusions to bring up his cell count. Bradley has also had three spinal taps and one bone marrow aspiration to make sure the leukemia didn't get into his spine. He now has a "picc" line in his arm so he can continue to get blood transfusions should he need them. The picc line is also used for Bradley's chemo therapy that he undergoes once a week.

Bradley and his family live in Sweetwater, Oklahoma but his parents take him to the Children's Hospital in Oklahoma City every

Friday for chemo therapy. He is home right now, but a nurse comes to change the bandage on the picc line and check on him often. He also has to take seven different medications to help fight the leukemia and to ensure he doesn't get any infections.
