# Peanut Short Course Planned Feb. 17-20 For Area Counties

The Peanut Short Course to be held in the Agricultural Building Across the street from the high school in Rising Star for growers in Eastland, Callahan, and Brown Counties

on February 17, 18 and 20 is only one of a series to be held in the peanut growing areas of the state, according to Eastland County Agent J. M. Cooper.

The meetings to begin at 7:30 p. m. on the above dates will be a presentation of various phases of production, disease and insect control, harvesting and marketing, it was said.

A different team of specialists and research personnel will be on the program at each of the three nights. A certificate will be given to those who attend all three of the meetings.

Rising Star was chosen for the short course since it is adjacent to growers in both Callahan and Brown Counties as well as to local growers.

Topics such as diseases, fungi, insects and weed control, fertilizers, varieties, irrigation practices, equipment and sources, farm management and marketing will be discussed in detail during the three meetings.

Those on the program from the A&M University include Ben Spears, Wendell Horne, W. H. Newton, H. P. O'Neal and Dr. T. D. Aaron; also, B. G. Freeman, Area Farm Management Specialist, Stephenville. Also from the Agricultural Experiment Station there will be B. C. Langley, superintendent.

H. L. Geyer, Rising Star Agricultural teacher; John Galloway, Brown County Agent; Pat Garner, Callahan County Agent, and the agricultural division of the County Program Building Committee from each county are also cooperating in the affair. The Chamber of Commerce there will furnish refreshments. Each night according to A. D. Jenkins, manager.
