All that Warburg predicted happened. All that Coolidge and Brisbane and all the other Solomons of their kind predicted did not happen. It will be recalled that they said prosperity would remain with us forever.

Now Paul Warburg is an optimist. His latest is that "no sane person doubts that eventually the depression will end and that a country as unique in resources and opportunities as ours will ultimately get back in its stride." Warburg is a bit timid in his use of words or in the coining of his phrases. A country as unique in resources and opportunities as ours always gets back in its stride. This is its history for 150 years. This is the history of civilized nations for centuries and centuries. Those who read and think and know history did not need the reminder from the lips of Warburg but they did need his voice of optimism to lift the mental malady that has tortured the minds and wrecked the souls of millions of Americans of the well-to-do type who have been fearful all along that the world is going straight to hell and that the republic of the fathers is the leader of the procession.

POWER OF I. C. C. DEFINED BY SUPREME COURT.

The interstate commerce commission has been dealt two body blows by the supreme court of the United States. First the court of last resort set aside a commission order that Florida intrastate freight rates on logs be increased and second ruled a special fund of \$3,500,000 created in the reorganization of the Saint Paul railroad was free from the control of the I. C. C. Justice Stone, Brandeis and Holmes dissented from the Saint Paul decision while Chief Justice Charles Evans Hughes took no part in its consideration. The railroad had maintained this fund was created to pay the fees of counsel and reorganization managers.

In a case from New Jersey the court sustained the validity of uniform insurance commission in its first five to four decision since Chief Justice Hughes and Justice Owen J. Roberts went upon the bench. They lined up with Justice Holmes. Brandeis and Stone, the three so-called liberals of the court. Another decision is worthy of more than passing note. Illegal methods used by the prohibition authorities in searching the premises of the Gogart corporation on Fifth avenue, New York city, were severely censured and evidence inlawfully obtained was ordered returned.






