## Too Many Slaps From Lady Luck Causes Old Salt to Abandon Venturesome Seas

 CORPUS CHRISTI, Tex., Sept. 24.—After 44 years of cruising over the bounding main, Harry Martin wants a job where he can have a solid footing again.

When a youngster, he ran away from home to go to sea. He has been in 16 shipwrecks, and plans to establish an association for caring for sailors who have survived marine disasters.

Martin came into port here stowed his sea tocs and decided to settle down for a while. "Constant excitement," he says, is responsible for the fact that he looks a score of years younger than he is.

Martin has had ships under him to burn, explode, break up and sink. The first vessel he served on pounded to pieces off Cape Horn in 1889. His last regular quarters

were on the Seantie, which burned at her New Orleans pier during the Mardi Gras fire a few months ago.

When he was 15, he joined the crew of the square-rigged bark Dorothy Hicks, simply by sliding down the grain chute into her hold and keeping out of the way until she was well away from Portland, Ore. This vessel went to pieces out of Buenos Aires in the blast of an Argentine typhoon. Martin and 18 other survivors escaped on a raft and only 11 were rescued.

Two years later, when the Marjorie Pagan, another square rigger, broke up, he says he caught a spar and rode it for two days and nights and then swam to shore.

The Gilbert Morgan went to pieces while he was aboard it in the Straits of Magellan. The next steamer, the Eagle, caused Martin

and 11 others to stay in a life-boat for five days.

The masts, bridge, funnels and beams of the Ellen Fisher were carried away in 1897 off the Cocos islands, but the ship was saved, with Martin aboard. The Golden Gate was twisted out of shape and sank in a storm, and the oil tanker Cochran caught fire and burned off the coast of Ireland in 1912, with Martin among the rescued.

According to his story, he was on the Kanowna when she was torpedoed and sunk in the Mediterranean; the Minnewaska when she was torpedoed off the coast of Greece, and the Helen Qezada at Salina Cruz that was seized by revolutionists.

For a decade Martin had not been in a wreck. In 1929 he set out from Norfolk to Genoa and the Quimistan lost a plate under the water, and the crew was later picked up from small boats.

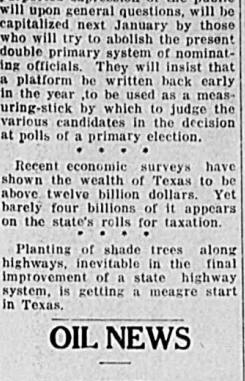
