## 91st Court Case Filings Down Only 2 Over 19 Last Year

AUSTIN - The number of cases filed in district court in Eastland County during 1972 was 2 cases less than the number filed during the 1971, according to statistics released by the Texas Civil Judicial Council.

Cases filed during the last calendar year totaled 341, including 84 criminal and 257 civil.

Judge Earl Conner, Jr., of the 91st District Court has jurisdiction in Eastland County.

The local district court disposed of 262 cases during 1972, 38 percent of the cases filed during the year or carried over from 1971. At the end of the year, 433 cases were pending on the docket.

These state courts disposed of 51 per cent of the total cases filed in 1972 or carried over from 1971. The defendant entered a guilty plea in 47 per cent of the criminal cases disposed of. In the cases disposed of by a jury verdict, 74 per cent of the defendants were

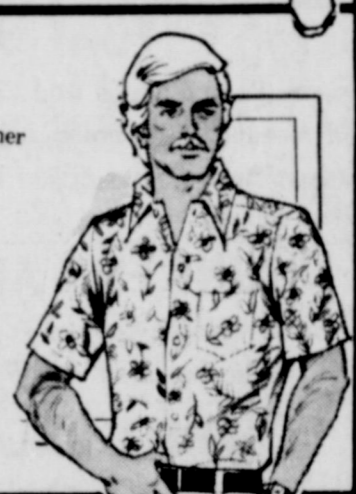

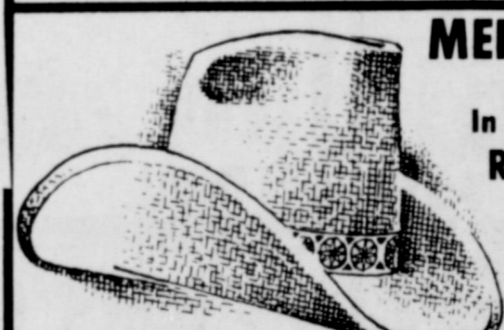
