## GROWING $\mathbb{N}$ GRACE

Have you grown spiritually since you were This question comes to me because I am made to realize that many of us have not. And yet, according to God's Word, we are expected to show a spiritual growth. Paul, In talking to the Brethren at Corinth urged them to grow in grace which helped them to grow spiritually with the Saviour. They were to become adults in Christ, however, at the time of his writing unto them, they had not grown sufficiently. For he said, "And I brethren could not speak unto yoo as unto spiritual, but as unto carnel, even. unto babes in Christ. I have fed you with milk and not with meat, for hither to ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able." 1 Corinthians $3: 1-2$. Is this also an indictment against the Christian of our day? Perhaps so.

Let us think together about growing in grace. Since we are expected to grow in it, what does it mean? I feel that the answer may be found in II Peter 3:17-18, "Ye, therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your own steadfastness. But grow in Grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever. Amen
From the above scripture quotations we may draw these conclusions. Grace is God's preventive from falling from-steadfastness. Therefore, as we grow in grace we grew in steadfastness. Not only is it preventive, but it is also, God's unmerited favor toward man. Therefore, we must grow in the realization of that which God has done for us, such as saving our souls and making daily provision for our lives. We must realize that we are to have an outstanding experience with grace and from that day forward we are to continually grow in Christian experience. Growing in grace is the act of maturing in Adult Christianity. Maturity produces works. Just as the child matures into adulthood it ceases play and assumes responsibility, so does the maturing Christian. Work does not produce maturity, but it is the sign of maturity.
As we look at the life and work of the average Christian today, are we Justified in assuming that Paul also wrote 1 Corinthians $3: 1-2$ unto us?
