Forty Boats Ordered to Mississippi -Region

(By The Associated Press.) WASHINGTON, April 30. ---Plans for the largest relief expedition in the history of the coast guard went forward today when forty boats with crews were ordered to proceed to Natchez, Miss., from Lewes, Del., and Ashbury Park, N. J.

One hundred and fifty craft will be assembled at New Orleans for relief work along the Mississippi.

Flood Danger Alarming NEW ORLEANS, April 30 .- (AP) The nations most disasterous flood was spreading tonight with increasing rapidity and federal and state officials mad no attempts to conceal their growing apprehension of dangers yet to come.

Driven madly by the slowly moving crest, the Mississippi swelled over part of the levee at Vicksburg, flooding the lower section of that city and sloughing off 100 feet of the main levee at Glasscock, La. It threatened inundation of Concordia and parts of adjoining parishes.

Increasing volumes of water were owing through three gaps in the Amarillo men to build a butter and





# "SO CALM, SO MAJESTIC---SO SLOW AND RELENTLESS"

That's The Mississippi River of Today Which Has Made 150,000 Homeless and Caused Huge Property Losses

Beginning, man has gathered at the river. It has enriched his soil, watered his flocks and herds, and transported his goods to the market places.

Men crowded in along the Nile and settled there, they moved in along the Rhine, and the Tiber and the Danube; and more than 1900 year ago, when Caesar's galleys swept up the gloomy Thames, they were there, peering out from the underbrush with startled eyes.

The river has always called with a lure like that of the sea, and man has always built his proudest cities on their bluffs.

Today, there are more than 150,-000 people in this vase section from whom the Father of Waters has taken away. Their lands have been ravaged, their homes wrecked and their valued possessions sent bobbing along the current like corks on a mill pond.

To understand what has happened to this fertile valley of the Mississippi, one must understand what was there before.

From Cairo to Vicksburg, the kissing the banks on either side winds along by pleasant meadows, and through green-leafed groves; it laps softly at the landing places.

From the river back there stretch vast fields which lose themselves in the purple smudge hanging over the timber line far away. The photograph shown above is probably the most remarkable flood picture ever taken. It shows a Missouri Pacific refugee train, trying to get several hundred of the homeless in the Mississippi valley to refugee camps at Memphis. For nearly a day, the train was reported lost. A flying camerman for NEA Service was one of the aviators who discovered it, creeping very slowly through the flooded areas. The flood waters kept Mississippi coils and uncoils lazily, extinguishing the fires of the engine and threatening a boiler explosion, but the engineer and fireman courageously stuck to the task until all the refugees were brought to dry land. "Fashion," he said, "is the greatest enemy feet have for it decrees and prosecution in Federal court. that one must wear a certain style of shoe regardless of comfort.

"Broken arches precede a broken countenance; the feet are mirrored in the face.

Shoes are either too narrow or two short, heels are too high or too low. Frequently the inside line of the great toe, which should point in the direction one is traveling, is not straight enough.

Hose are usually too short, which brings about ill-shaped toes and retards circulation. Continuous ill-treatment of the feet produces deformed feet. This can be demonstrated by comparing the hands and feet of a little girl and those of a grown woman. The feet of the two are hot the same shape, but the hands are.

"Women are not alone in having foot troubles. Out of the first million men examined for army service there were 177,000 with flat feet, so judging by this there are 20,000,-000 people in the United States with





Railroads are things to watch closely, being large organizations with devious ways of bringing things about. Unfortunately, they represent huge expenditures which are in prospect of making good returns in the future only by placing rates where they will be most productive and giving much attention to the principle of "what the traffic will bear."

But railroads are not alone responsible for changes in tariffs. Fort Worth and Dallas have obtained from the Interstate Commerce Commission a ruling which practically abolishes the common point freight rate in West Texas, with great benefit to jobbers and wholesalers in those cities, but detri-

ment to traffic centers. The common point rate has been important to West Texas because it made wholesale business profitable, but abolishment would strike a blow at these firms. 



Then sellers began to see that advertising was just another name for reputation and, since advertising cost money it was obvious that reputation had a cash value.





Prof. J. L. Lester and **Students Have 3** Plots

### WHEAT PLANTS **ARE STIMULATED**

### **General Belief Is That** Fertilizer Will Not **Pay Profit**

Application of nitrate of soda to wheat lands in this vicinity, as part of an experiment conducted by J. L Lester, professor of vocational agriculture in Pampa high school, already has shown results.

Experimental plots clearly demonstrate that the fertilizer has a beneficial effect upon the plants. The edges are distinct where the treatment of ground was left off. The mitrate of soda was obtained from the educational bureau of the organization which distributes the Chilean product in this country. George L. Foster, district manager with headquarters in Dallas, sent the nitrate here for experimental use, with the following comment:

Value Doubted.

"It is generally considered that nitrate, or any fertilizer material, will not pay a profit in the section of the state where you are located. and this being the case, it would hardly be wise to send a large amount of nitrate to be tried the first year. However, I am of the opinion that you can tell whether or not nitrate will give good results with the 200 pounds the first year. then if favorable results are obtained, I am sure that arrangements can be made whereby a large amount can be furnished you.'

The county commissioners had previously set the interest rate at 5 1-4 per cent and had the bonds printed at that figure, but when the lower bid was submitted they decided to have the bonds reprinted. Potter county bonds sold for 5 per cent.

Carson county has been given an allotment of \$200,000 in state and federal aid to match her \$200,000 set aside out of a million-dollar issue to pave 20 miles from the Potter county paving toward White Deer. This apportionment amounts to \$30,000 a mile and will construct highgrade concrete roads.




