Texans are so proud of the Lone Star State that they can hardly sleep at night. If a Texan's head should be opened, the map of the state would be found on his brain!

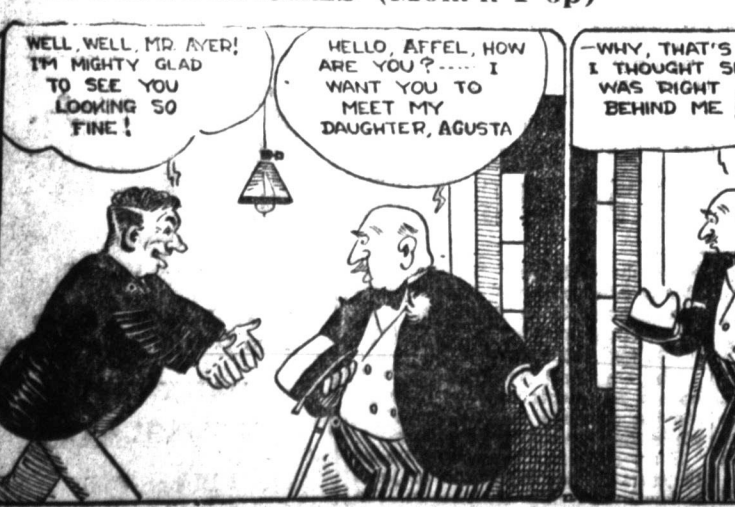

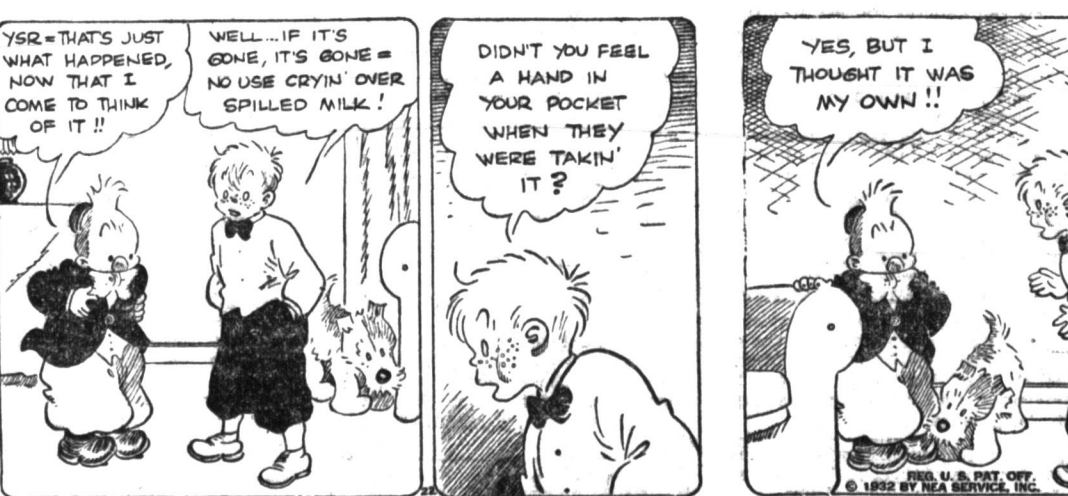

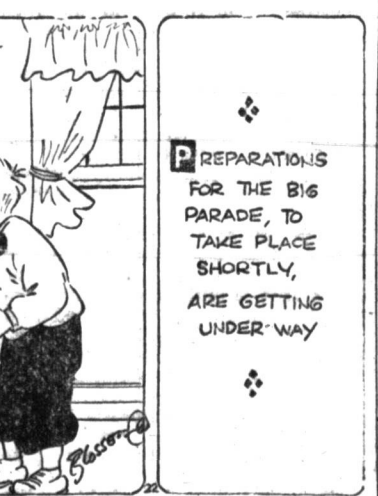
