## Let The Church Be The Church

In our day it has-become a popular past-time to ridicule the church to criticise it as being not relevant to our day. It is blamed for many of the social ills of cur day. It is called archaic and out of step with the umes. Somehow our society has come to the realizaticn that the world is not as it ought to be and in a sense of frustration has sought a scape-goat.
Because it is the church that is in the business of salvaging the souls of men and transforming lives through Jesus Christ, the church was the logical scape-goat.
