# Docking With Collins Is Next

first exploration of the lunar surface today, sealed themselves back in the spaceship Eagle and slept fitfully until the start of their hazardous voyage home to earth.

The dramatic operations to remove Neil A. Armstrong and Edwin E. Aldrin Jr. from the alien world began at 9:30 a.m. C.D.T. when the ground controllers awakened Michael Collins, circling the moon alone in the command ship Columbia.

Armstrong and Aldrin, weary of the airless, arid surface that turned their blue space boots cocoa colored, were allowed to sleep as long as possible in the Eagle before being called to begin preparations for their blastoff from the moon.
