\hline - The most important legislation of 1963'" will be before the House of Representatives as most of you read this newsletten Known to most citizens simply as "the tax
bill." this measure's major provisions include an across - the board cut in individual and corporate income tax rates. Because of its impact on virtually every Americancitizen and business firm, the tax bill has brought more concentrated public and Congressional attention than any other piece of pending legislation. You've probably read of the
bill's provisions papers and heärdTthem discussed at length in teleyision and radio reports. Perhaps you've deter.
mined by how much your own taxes would be reduced and the \(\mathrm{e}^{\text {tl }}\) ects other provisions in the bill & \begin{tabular}{l}
would have on you or your business. Perhaps you've found things in the bill with which you disagree; few persons could agree
with every item in a bill 310 pages in length, although they might feel that "on balance" the bill is a good one. \\
